Enclosed are some rather primitive elaborations on the problem of liver transplantation - which I am certain should succeed to the degree at least of kidney transplantation. The only interesting work that I now have are 14 myocardial implants (single and both internal mammary's) 3 with ventricular aneurysms, 4 with followup angio's demonstrating potency, one with excision of an anterior myocardial infarct, no operative mortality so far.

I am anxious to get in a more academic position with research. I am certain that I did not get spoiled materially by the present situation. Could you let me know if you should hear about anything?

It was nice seeing you and your dear wife at the somewhat nostalgic occasion in Minneapolis.
