Medically - economically the situation over here developed beyond my expectations but otherwise reached a plateau (research, teaching).

If your group should ever be interested in coronary work for presentation, I have now 40 selective cine' angios - 2 patients with implants, 2 ventricular aneurysms - 4 followup internal mammary implants with patency in 4; 6 - 12 months postoperative with 0 mortality.
