

Dear Harold,

Thank you so much for your reproach copy about Justice's reaction and kind remark about my family. I am happy to be able to reproach me with a book about Peru with a picture of your famous father and I hope you'll enjoy it and that it is not going to make you homesick as it did to me and especially to my wife.

My wife and all my children arrived at the middle of January and I am very happy to have them here. The news from our pure country are not good at all, they have their food Friday but the Peruvian section seems to be too far away. I always hoped that I'd be able to go home in time my hospital is finished, in this instance I got another year to stay here legally but now I really doubt whether it would be possible. I still feel to be obliged to government under Dutkiewicz to return, and I would consider it as treason to my colleagues and people in Francisco, but I am afraid to get rid of it by the time with help of Peruvian banknotes.

The kids go to the school, they don't have any major problems as far as continuation of education without losing any year is concerned. They adjusted themselves without any problems in entering the my wife, she is still terribly homesick, her progress in English is very slow, because she speaks most the time at home.

I am about finishing my internship and I have been working parttime in Winton General Hospital at the emergency room, they provide me with a house, and it helped me quite a bit in the very first time of my family arrival, otherwise I would be not able to manage it. Regarding to my preparation for board examination

I can look for some reason. I was not sure that I am
going to appear for it, because of going home, I was very
busy working at day home in one hospital and night shifts
and weekends in the other. I am not able to send my
application neither, because being on Exchange Visitor pro-
gram - I have first to obtain Government I-20, after
that declaration of intention to be able to send my
form. But the worst obstacle seem to be my English
spoken & written, they require precise and return the parts;
about chemistry and other basic sciences. But, I hope
now, being forced, having more time I will do it.
Frankly speaking a little feel that I have to be educated
then or educate myself somebody else.

How have you decided about your university applica-
tion? I hope that the this letter and the book I
have sent today will reach you. According my last
information I would be able to get for Board certifica-
tion after two years of residency in surgery, which sounds
good it would not ^{be} a long time as I was afraid of.
I am sure that I feel all things are going to be clear
and before that I hope that I'll get occasion to see
you again, if you and your nice wife wouldn't mind
during my vacation, I have promised to my family to have
a lot to see as much as possible for the week.

Excuse me for my handwriting and my delay
I started many times my letter, but never was able to
finish it.
