Dear Doctor Absolon:

Thank you for your letter of May 29th. You can be assured that much of the progress made at St. Anthony's Hospital in the past few years has been made in large measure by your participation or counsel.

I presented your letter to the Executive Committee of the medical staff at its June meeting, and the committee was unanimous in endorsing the proposal that you be retained on the staff of St. Anthony's Hospital. The By-laws allow that you be appointed to the Honorary Staff of the medical staff of St. Anthony's Hospital.
