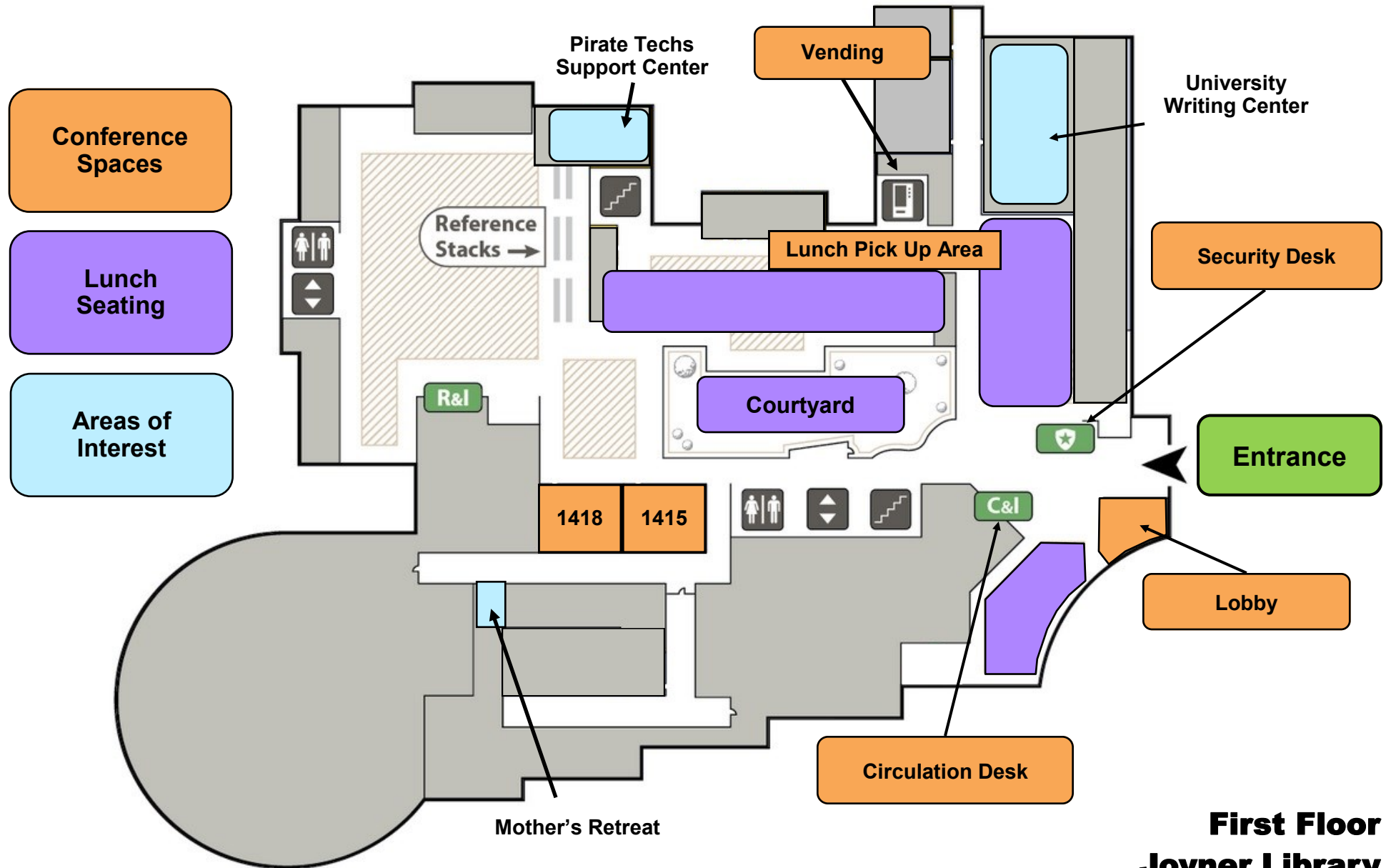

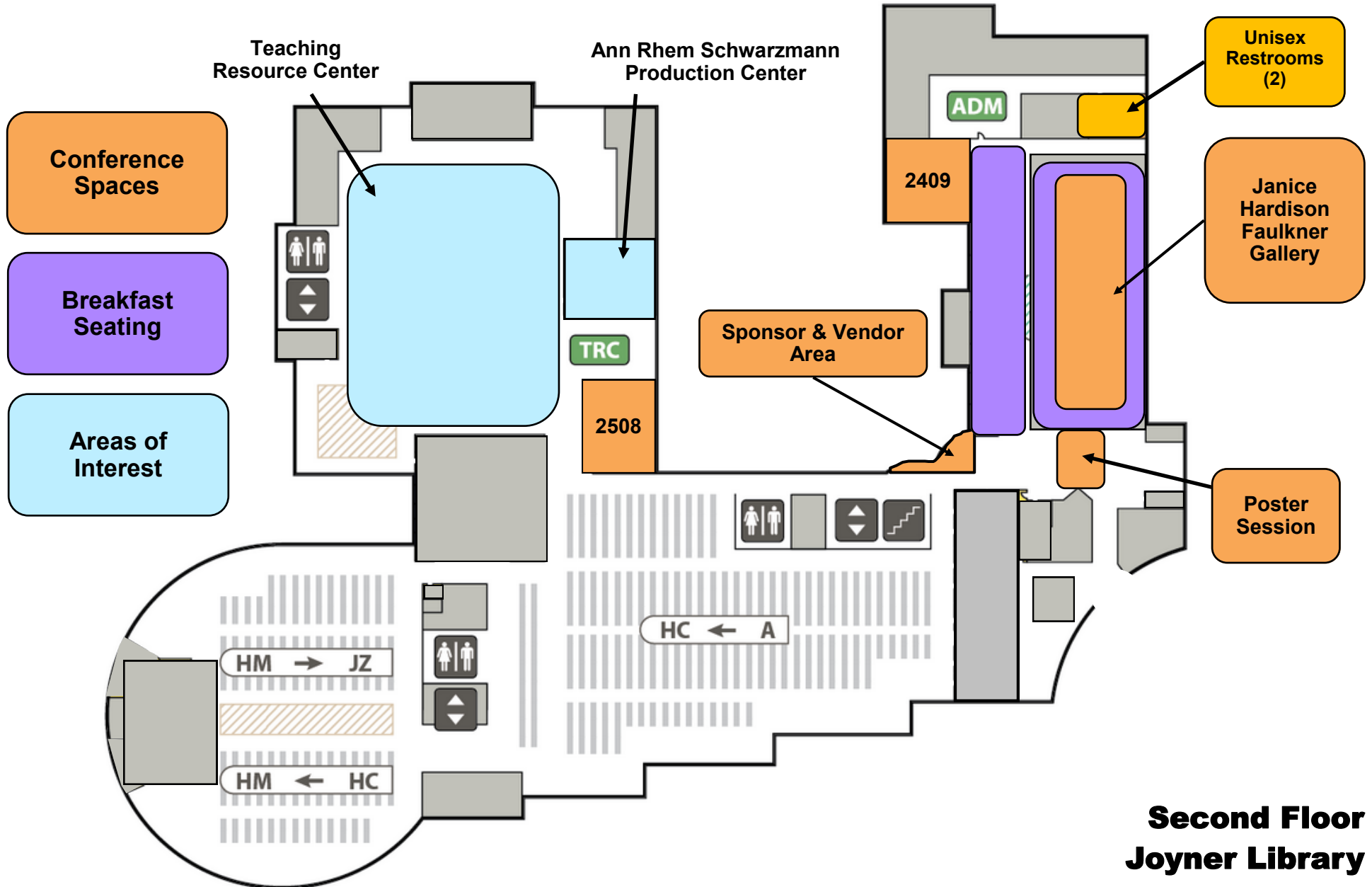

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Additional Information About Joyner Library's Areas of Interest

First Floor

Pirate Techs Support Center

Pirate Techs Student Computing Support Center assists students with network connectivity issues, Microsoft software installation, virus/Trojan horse issues, spyware/malware infections, and is a certified, full-service repair center for Dell, Lenovo and Apple computers with limited hardware support for most other computers.

University Writing Center

The University Writing Center (UWC) is open and available to students, faculty, and staff to work with undergraduate and graduate writing consultants on writing at any stage of the writing process. Their website provides a virtual place where writers can find resources to assist with writing at various points of the writing process. The menu above provides links to resources, such as writing guides for students and instructors, information about face-to-face consulting, and the opportunity for Distance Education students to submit writing for online consultation.

Interior Courtyard

Joyner Library's courtyard offers students the chance to relax or study al fresco at tables shaded by canopy umbrellas. Each table seats up to four people; additional benches line the courtyard's brick paver perimeter. Several modern sculptures by ECU School of Art and Design alumni, as well as the lush green landscaping, accentuate the open space. The courtyard is wheelchair accessible.

Mothers's Retreat

The Joyner Library Mother's Retreat provides a private space for nursing mothers to express breastmilk. The room includes electrical outlets, tables, chairs, a mini fridge, and donated supplies. Second Floor

Janice Hardison Faulkner Gallery

The Janice Hardison Faulkner Gallery is a dynamic space that serves a variety of purposes. It is both a presentation space and an exhibit area that showcase art created by ECU faculty and students. Students can use the gallery space individually and collaboratively when it is not reserved for events.

Teaching Resource Center

Established in 1988, the Teaching Resources Center (TRC) collection contains more than 60,000 titles. The collection includes children and young adult materials, K-12 North Carolina state adopted textbooks, mixed media, and reference resources. The TRC serves as a resource center for students enrolled in ECU's teacher education program and for educators in eastern North Carolina.

Ann Rhem Schwarzmenn Production Center

Part of the Teaching Resource Center, this production area features both a 3d Print Studio and the Ann Rhem Schwarzmenn Production Center. The 3d Print Studio includes multiple 3d printers available for student use, while the Production Center assists students in the creation and preparation of materials used in lesson units, classrooms, and presentations.
