19- all the Elders gathered at Bro Omerrys sang songs conversed etc they had an early dinner and left for Plymouth I wrote letter to Susy and we went down to Bro Browns and held meeting at night had a nice houseful both of us done the speaking.

-20- left Bro Browns come down to Sister Gortiers where we had dinner read the paper &c then come to Omerrys packed our grips and left for Swainers had a pleasant evening there

21- after breakfast took our departure for Gatersville went through Washington come on out the finetown road and while resting am writing my journal. come on out and staid all night with a disciple named McSilbert Jefferson conversed and talked with them till late at night.

22- Walked on to Gatersville and got our mail then went to Burris Wallises where we remained all night.

23- Sunday remained in house reading most of morning fast and prayed for Pres Miller Sister Sylvia Miller held meeting at 9 o'clock in the evening at Bro Burris had a house full I spoke on all the subjects I could think of then sat down had spoke 30 min. after supper went over and spent the evening with a Mr Pigggs and come back and staid all night again with Mr Burris.

24- Went down to Bath mailed our letters and walked thgh the city dodging around the Bow. T- on the side was sawe the oldest blurch (Episcopal) in the State it was a very old city and has gone to rack quite badly the Capital of the State was there years ago but it is said there is a curse on the place as a man come in there years ago to preach and the people rejected him and he

scraped the dirt off of his feet as a testimony against the city and it hasn't prospered since. we come on to John Curtin and there eat dinner. after dinner went down to Bay Side and notified the people of preaching at Curtin at night had quite a crowd out both of us doing the speaking.

25- wrote part of a letter then started out conversing sold a W of W. to Mrs Gailard at the P.O. conversed with the people along and took dinner with a Mr White then come on down to Mr McGowan where we are now.

26- Walked down to River and looked around a little then come back and wrote some Read book of Esther through for the family then retired about 10 o'clock - 27- Started out tracking met with many reasonable folks sold three books distributed many tracts and remained all night with Alexander Sawie's family he being absent but his son just newly married was at home - 28- Started for Mr Cox place waited on the shores of the creek for a long time for some one to come over after us finally Fenner Cox come from fishing his traps and carried us across he had half a barrel full of eels the lady and gent were neither at home the man come in the evening but we made it O.K. a hatching it sold three more books on that day. - 29- Mr Cox set us across and we went up to the P.O. but was disappointed in not getting any mail so we had to wait till Monday staid all nit with our Bishop where we sang songs - d conversed and retired about ten o'clock.
