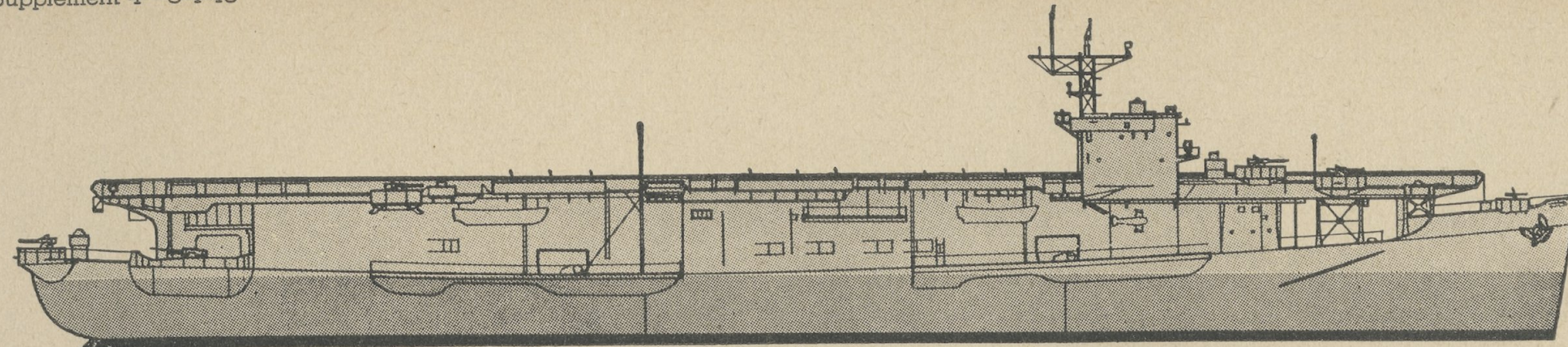
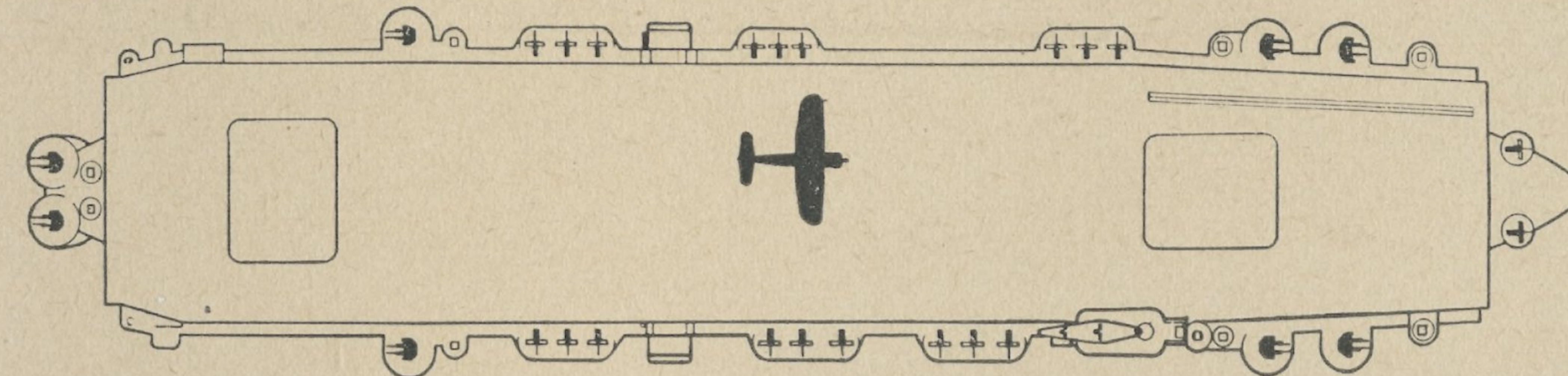

Converted from C-3 cargo hulls, these ships represent an improved CHARGER type. Often called "Baby Carriers", or by the British (who have sister ships) "Woolworth Carriers". Although divided into two classes there are no apparent appearance variations.

Observer's Note:

- Hull enclosed to flight deck.
- Standard CVE box bridge topped by trestle mast.
- Distinguished from other classes by presence of hull sponsons.
