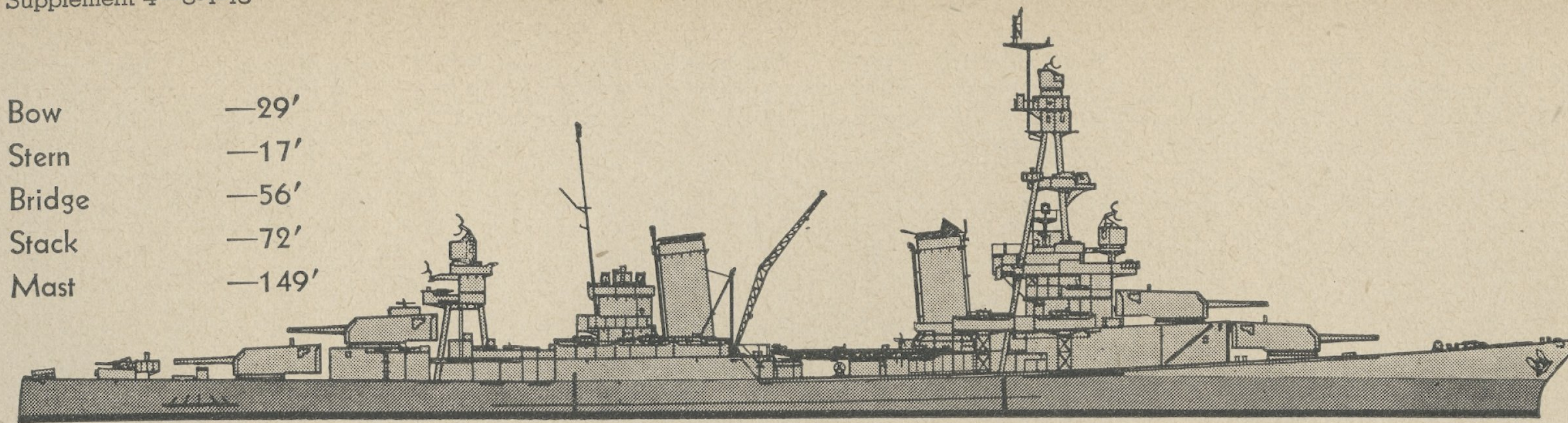
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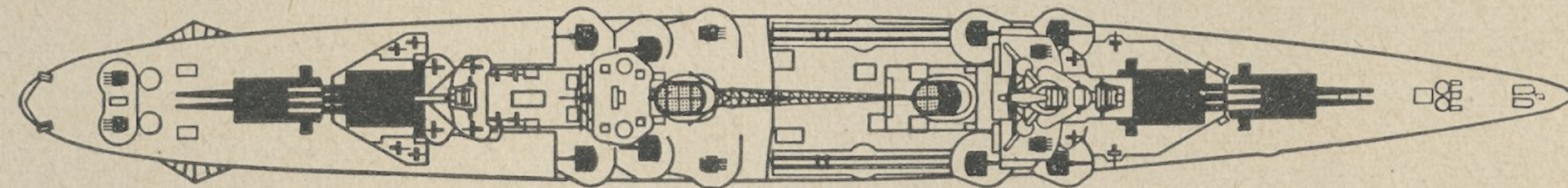

The first of our modern heavy cruisers, these ships were modified in the subsequent NORTHAMPTON-PORTLAND designs.

Observer's Note:

- 2-A-2 main battery disposition (triples over twins).
- Tall tripod foremast, pole mainmast, plus a tripod control tower aft.
- Two heavy, widely separated raking stacks.
- Flush hull, catapults amidships.
