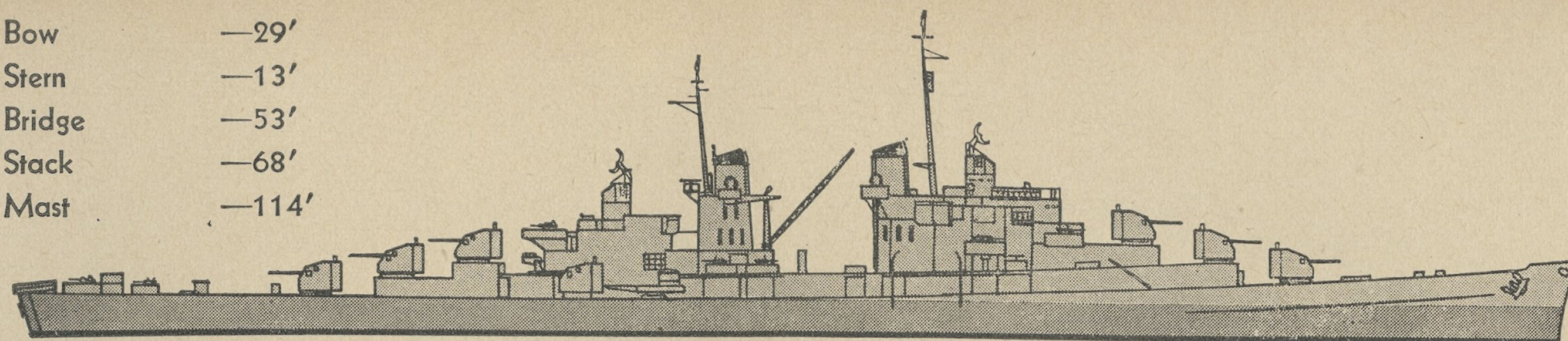

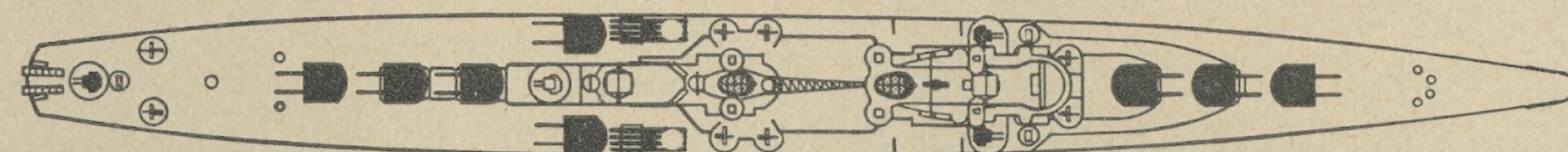

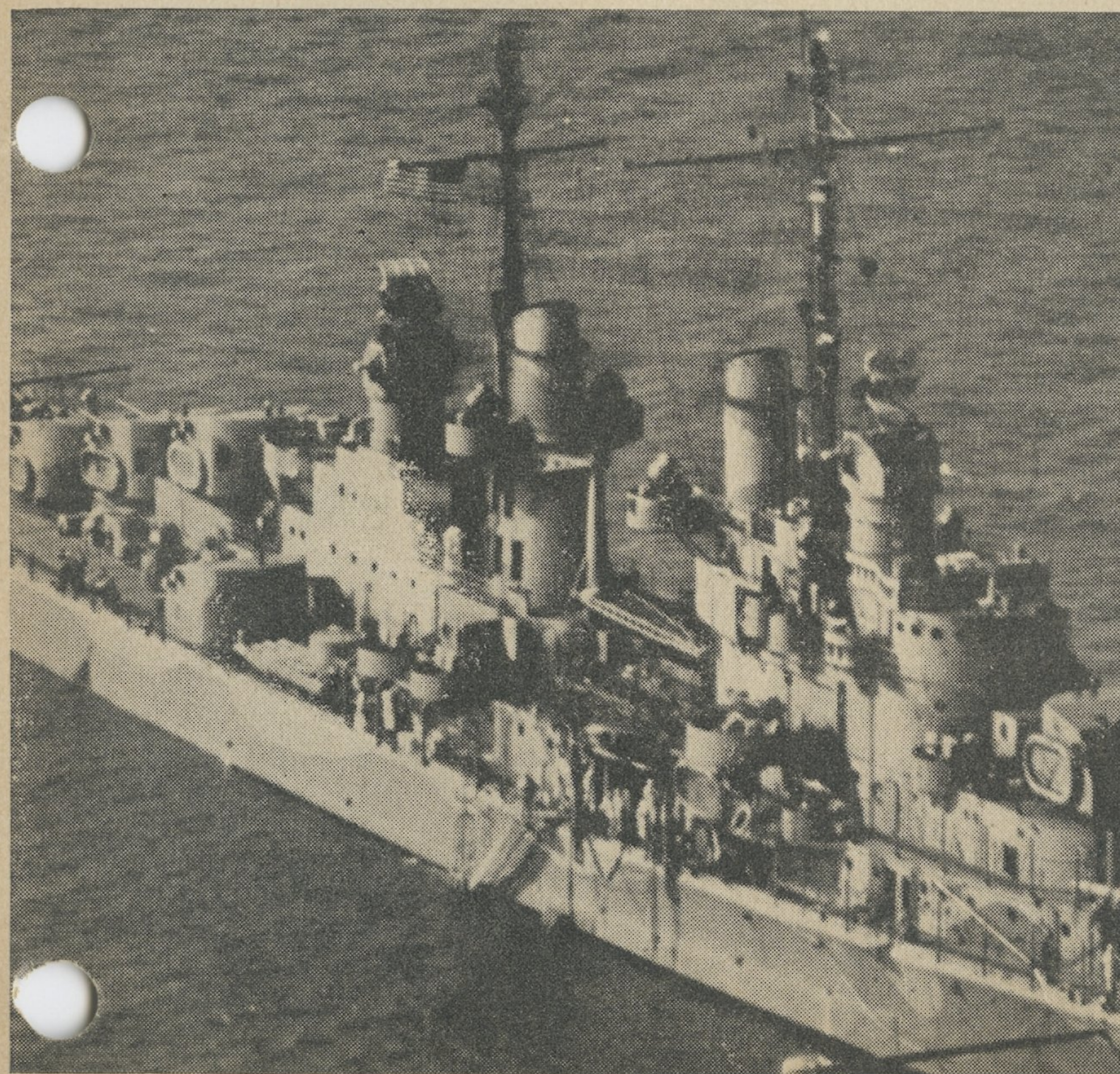

—Two thin stacks combined with superstructure.
