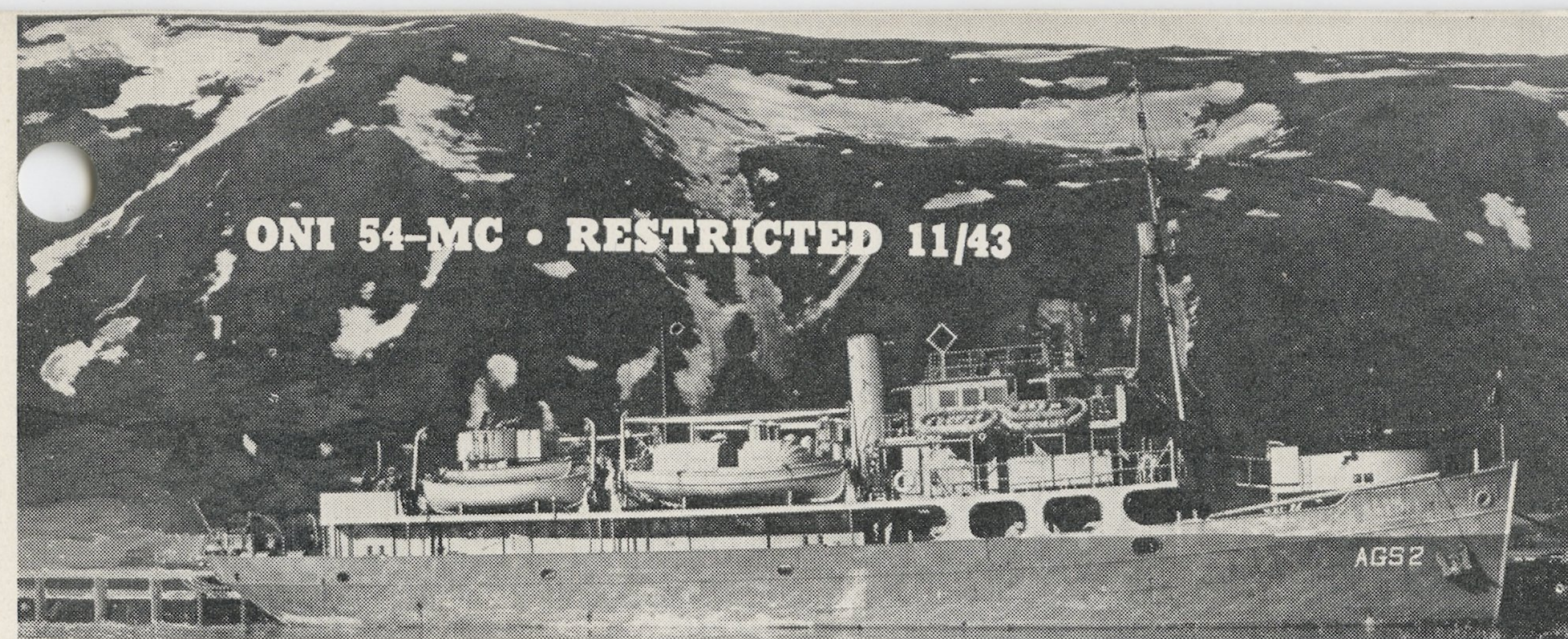

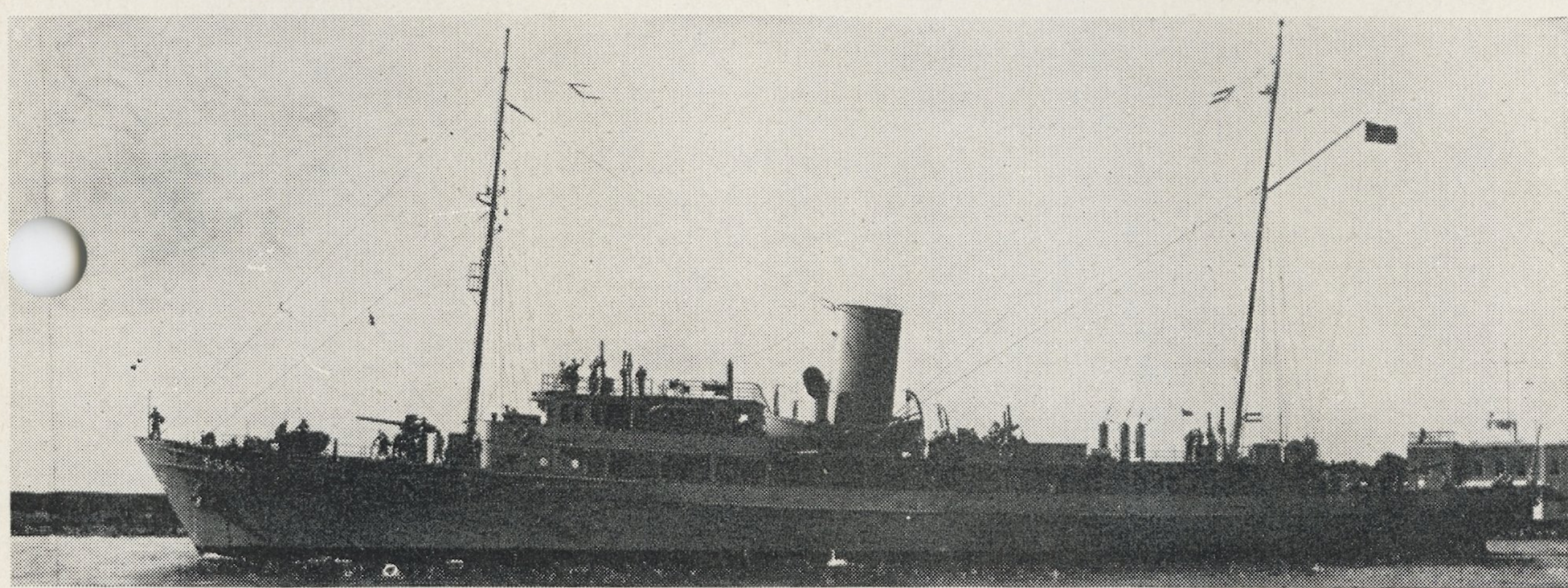


▲ AGS 2—HYDROGRAPHER, a surveying ship. Length overall, 164 feet.

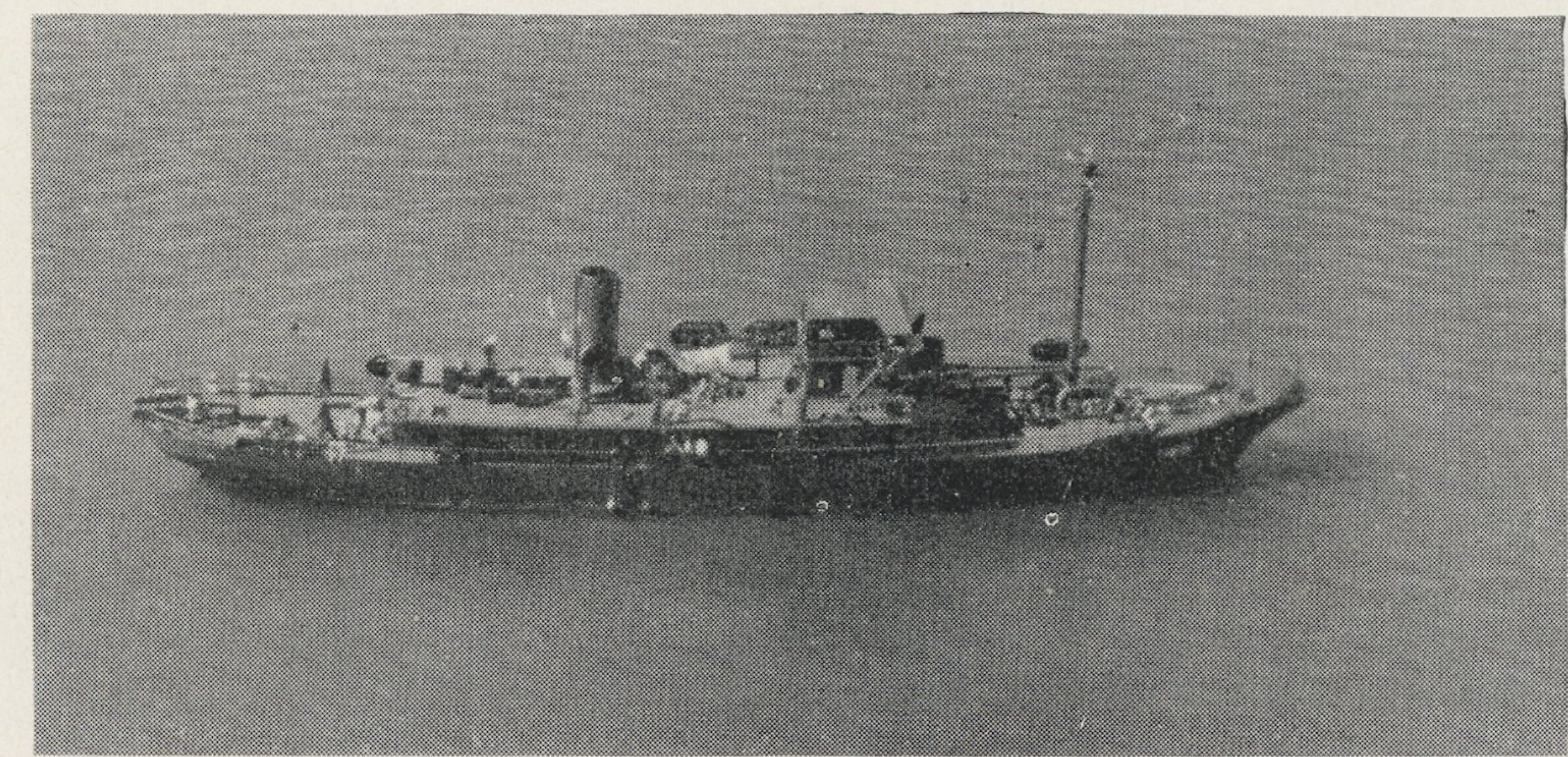
PG 59—SAN BERNADINO. ▶
