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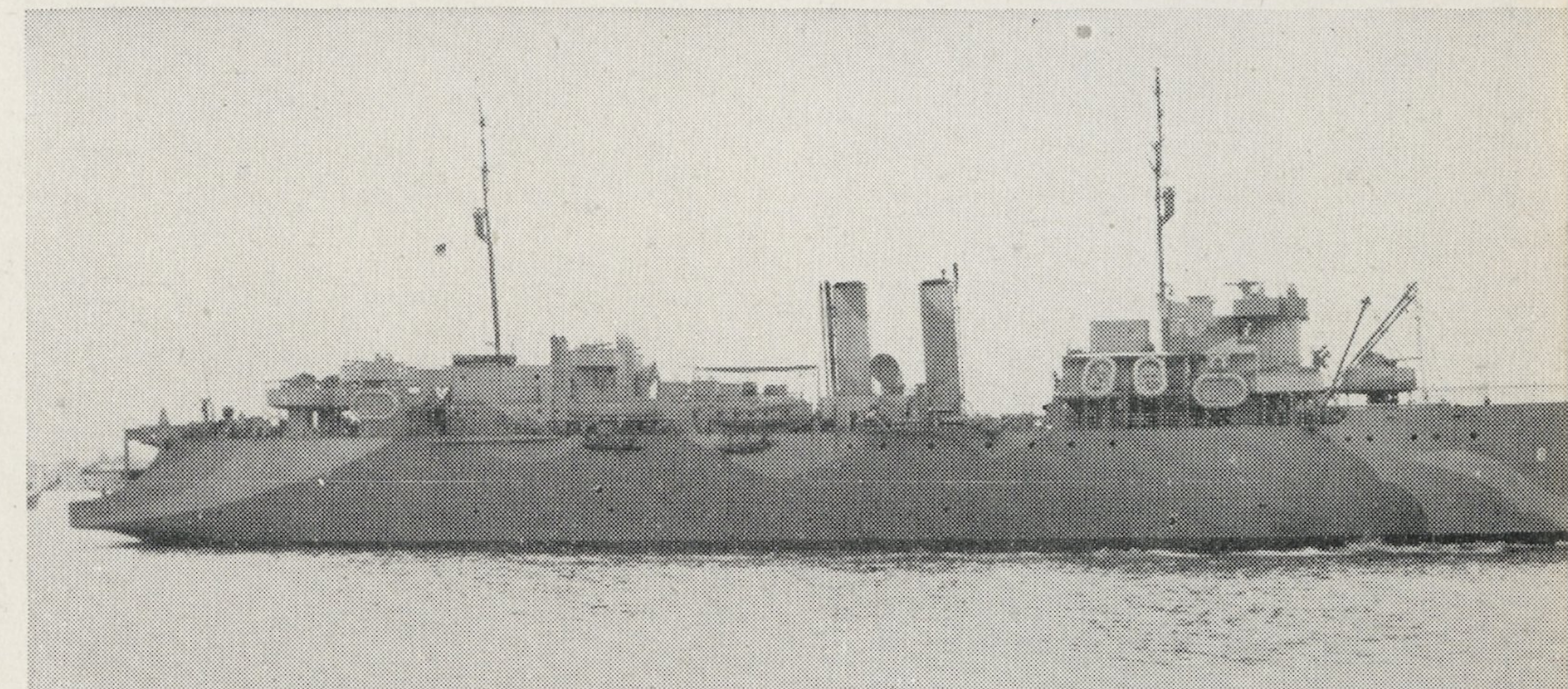
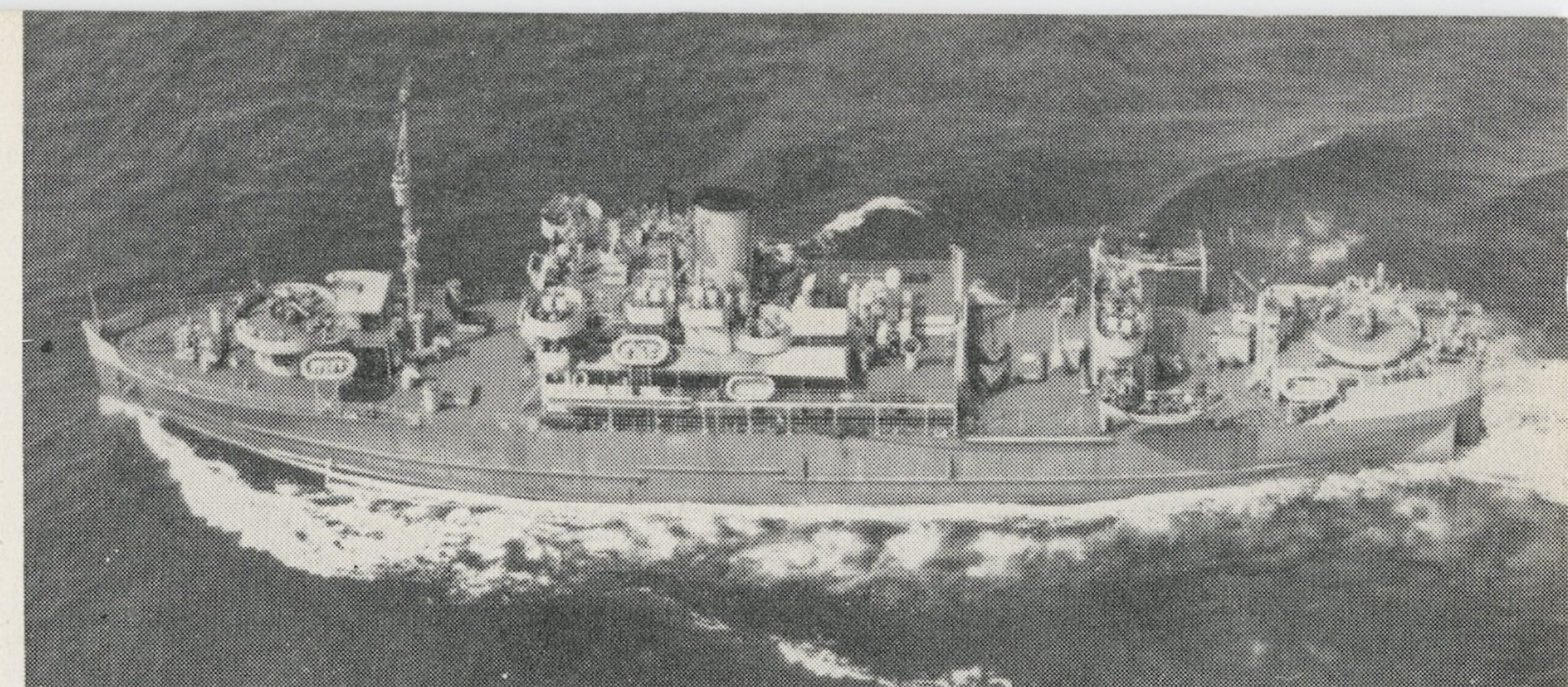
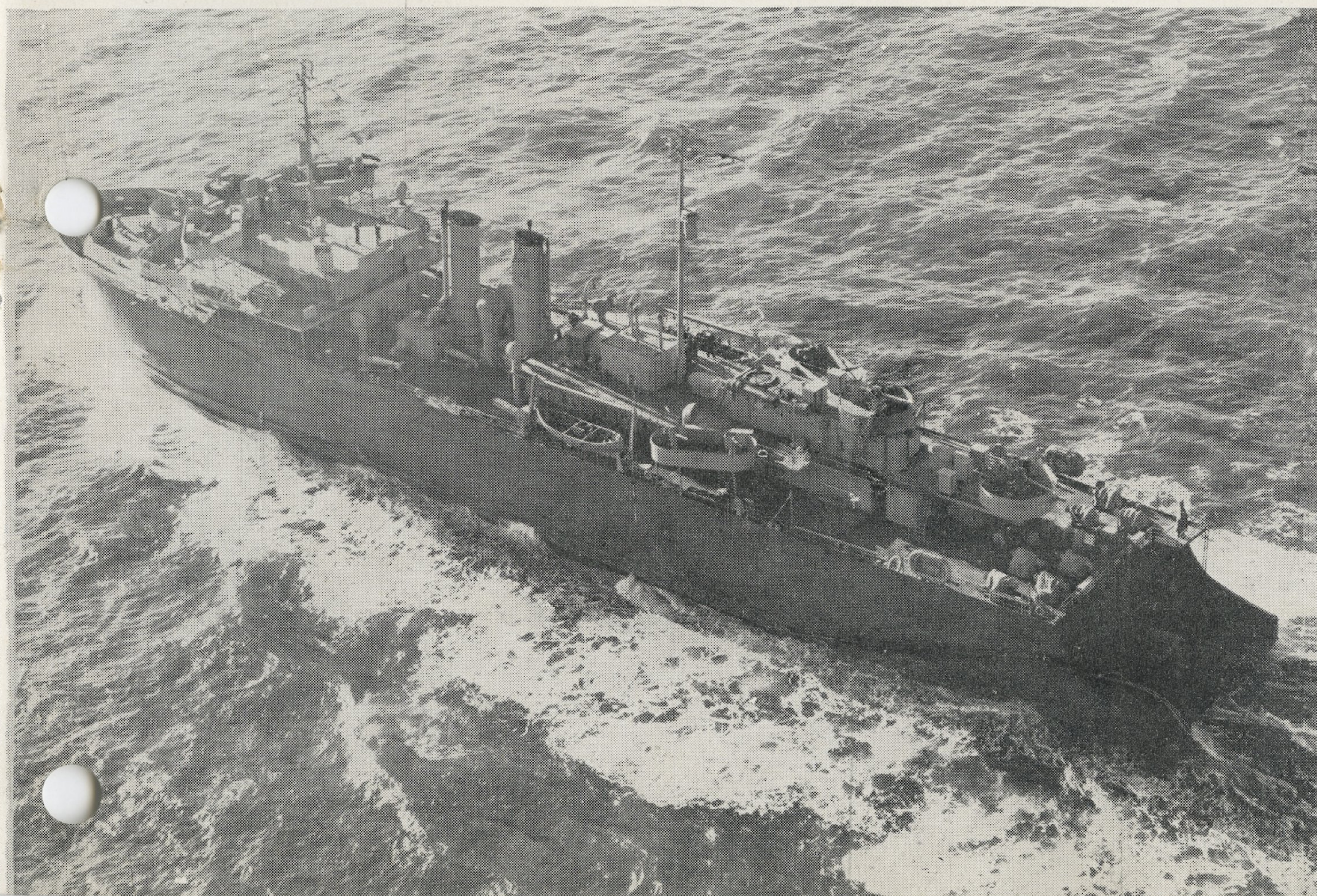

CMc 3 (Coastal Minelayer) WASSUC, displacement, 1,829 tons is shown on the Index Chart.

Five other CM's have been converted from merchant vessels. Largely used for coastal defensive work, they are also available for limited deep-sea operations. Three were formerly train ferries, two were cargo vessels.
