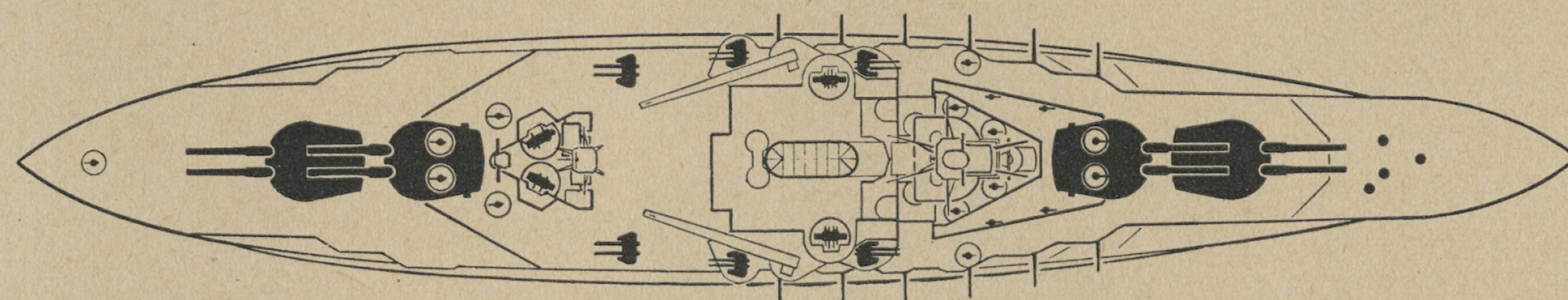
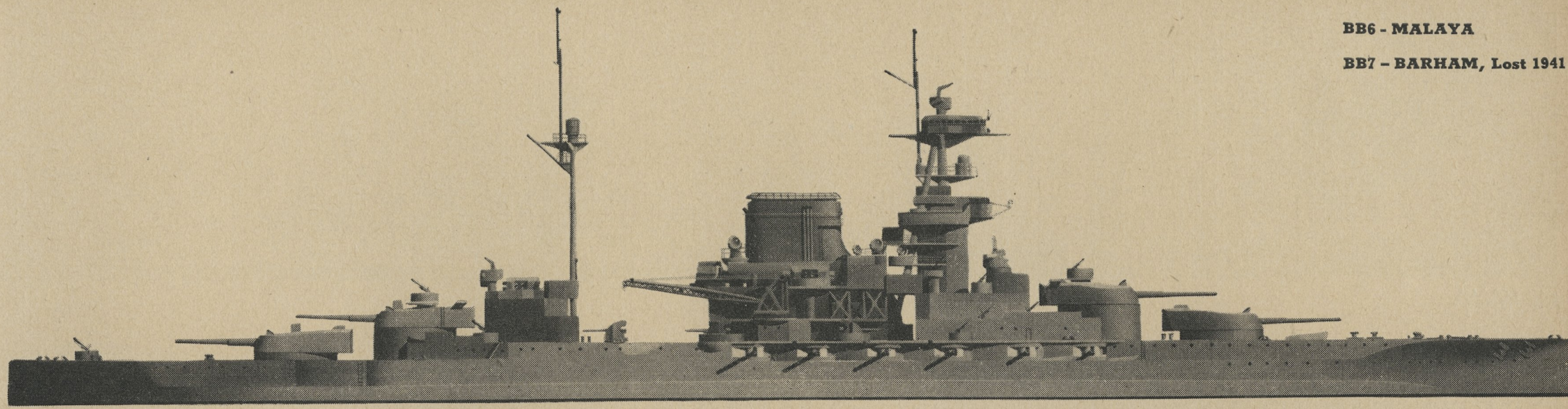

HEIGHT IN FEET:

from W. L.	to Top of Stack — 81'	to Top of Foretop — 113'
from Foc'sle Deck	to Top of Stack — 55½'	to Top of Foretop — 87'

LENGTH: 634½' (W. L.). **BEAM:** 104'

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES:

- Massive trunked stack, much broader than in the ROYAL SOVEREIGN Class.
- Heavy tripod foremast, tall pole mainmast.
- Secondary battery recesses extend well towards the bow; two on either beam in the quarterdeck (without guns).
- Athwartships catapult abaft stack; prominent aircraft cranes.
