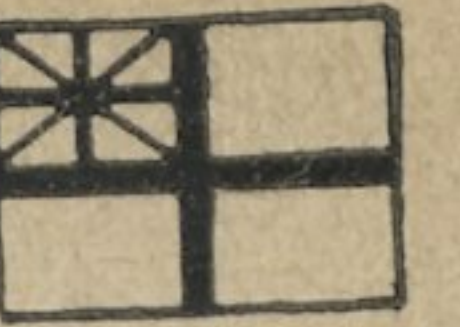
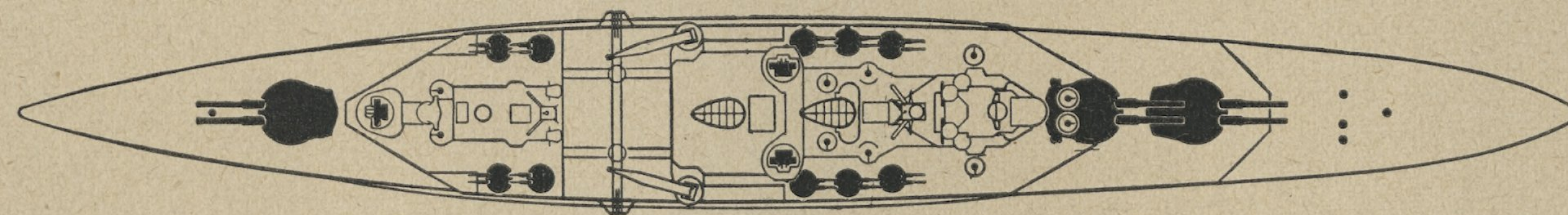
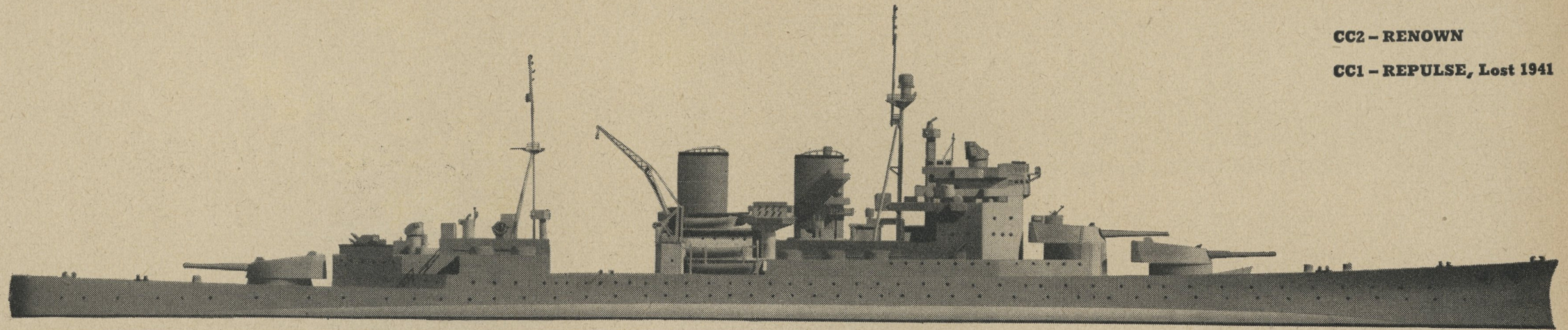


REPULSE Class (1 unit—RENOWN)

HEIGHT IN FEET:

from W. L.	to Top of Stack — $84\frac{1}{2}'$	to Top of Foretop — $123'$
from Foc'sle Deck	to Top of Stack — $59\frac{1}{2}'$	to Top of Foretop — $98'$

LENGTH: $787\frac{1}{2}'$ (W. L.). BEAM: $102'$

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES:

- The only capital ship in existence with three twin turrets, two forward and one aft.
- Two equal broad, stream-lined stacks placed forward of the catapult well deck.
- Tall tripod foremast stands clear of massive tower bridge; light tripod mainmast.
- Hull has cruiser lines when observed from the air.
