

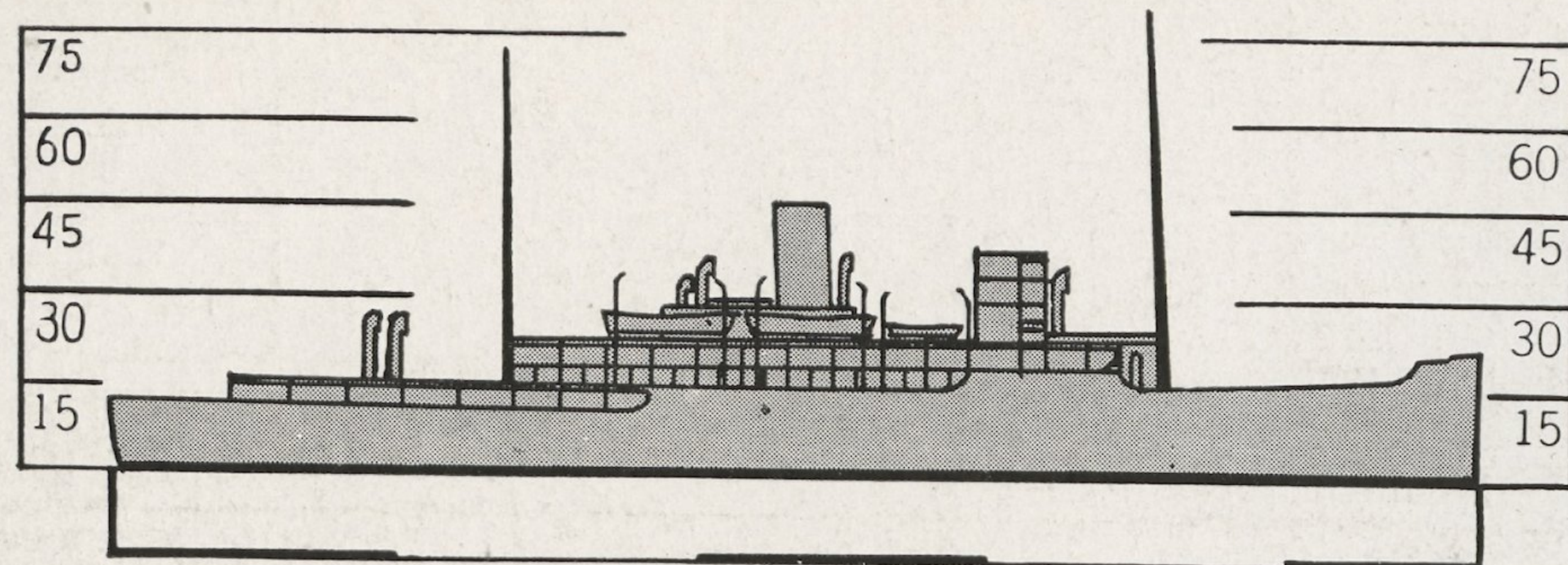

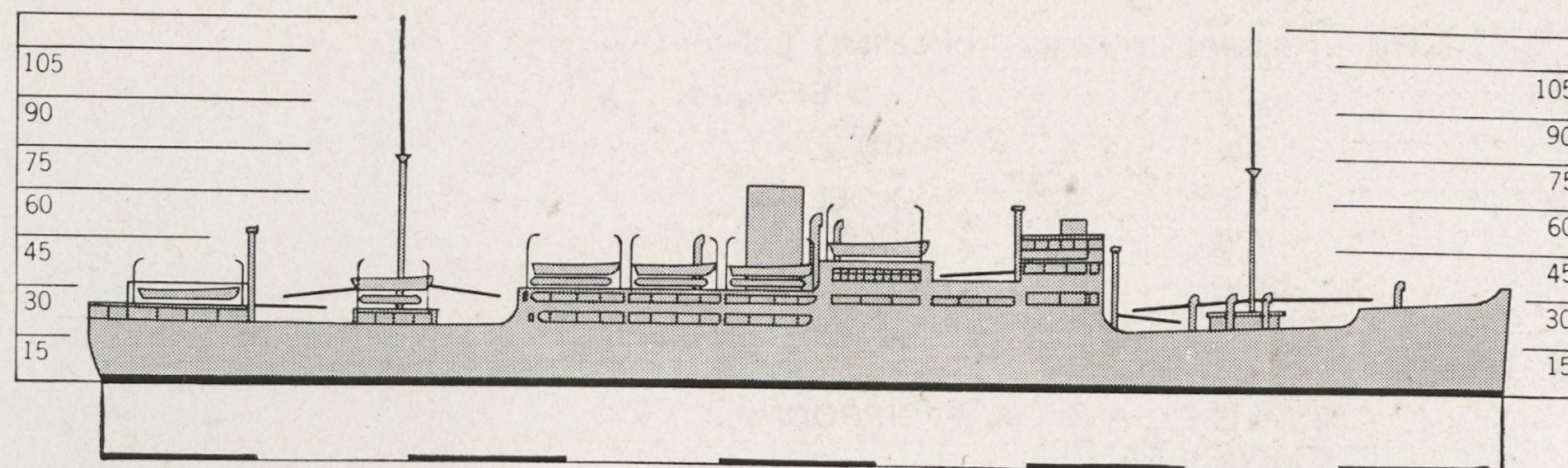


MURO MARU—AH 20—

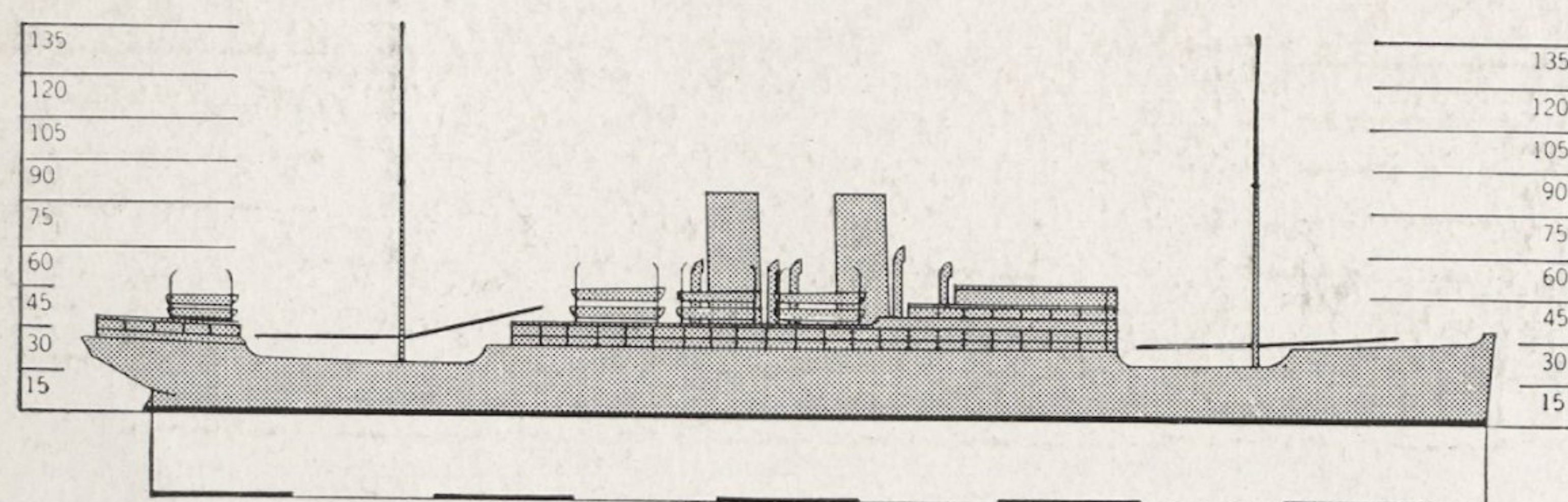

FUSO MARU—AH 16

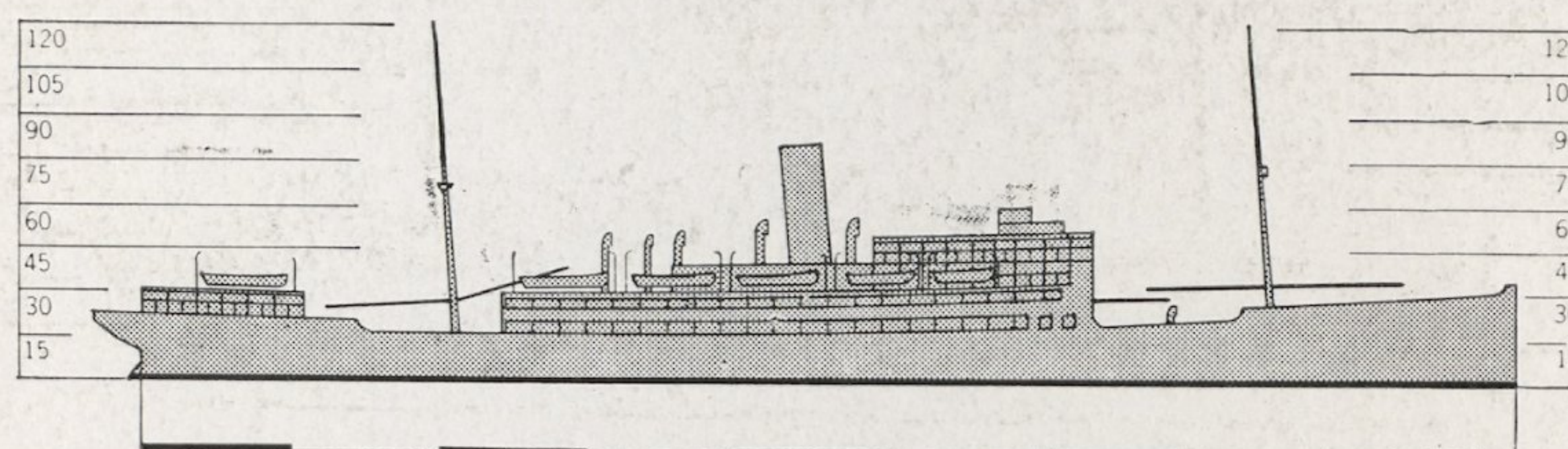

YOSHINO MARU—AH 18

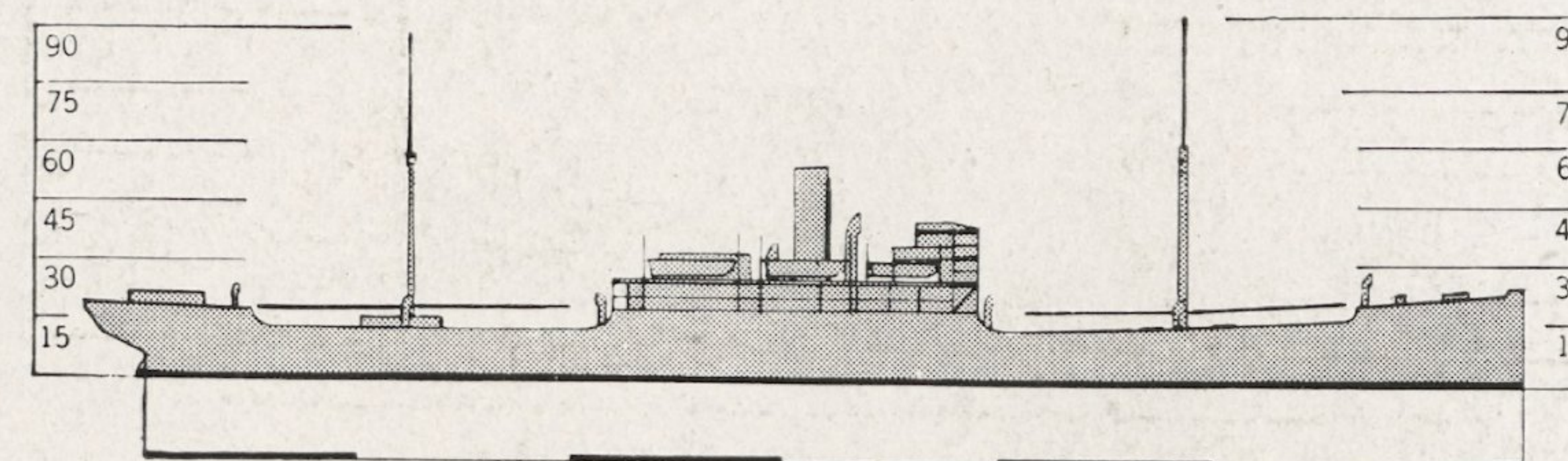
