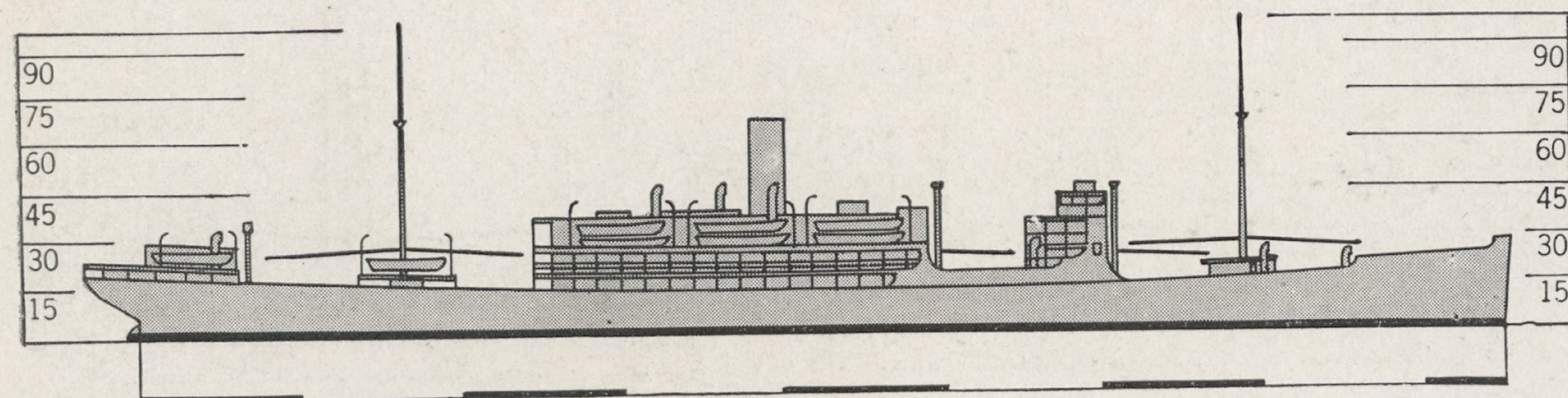

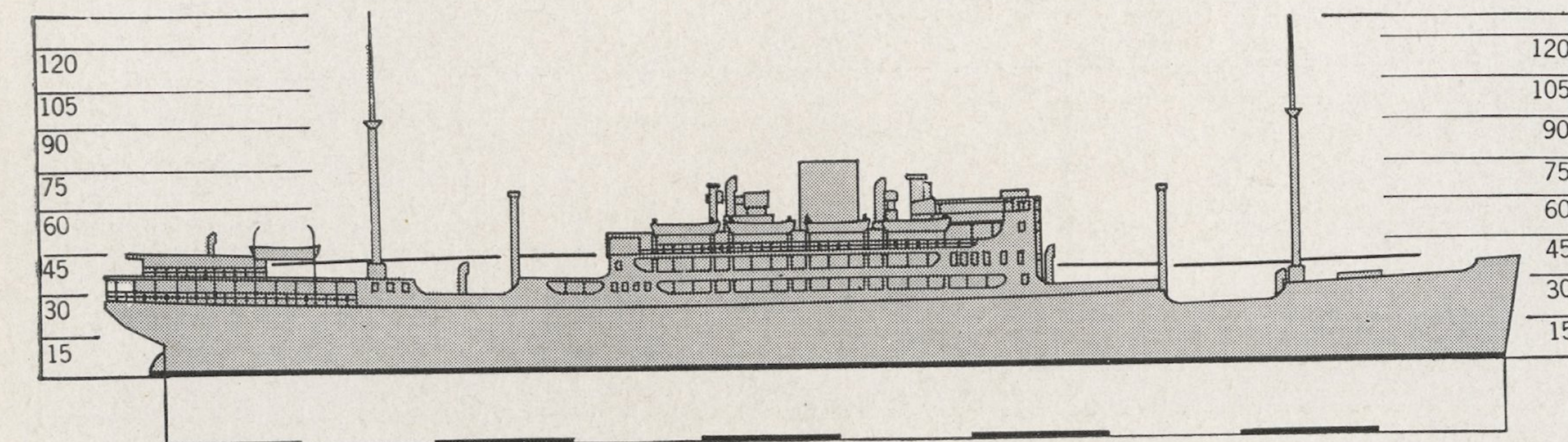
MANZYU MARU—XAS 1

YASUKUNI MARU—XAS 3

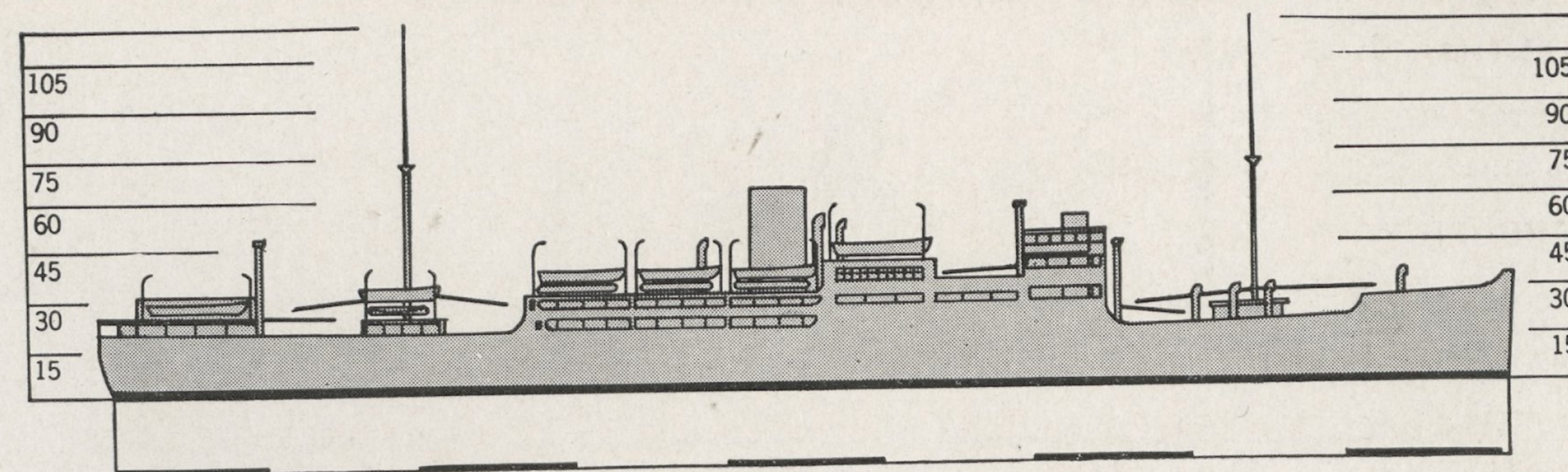

RIO DE JANEIRO MARU—XAS 2

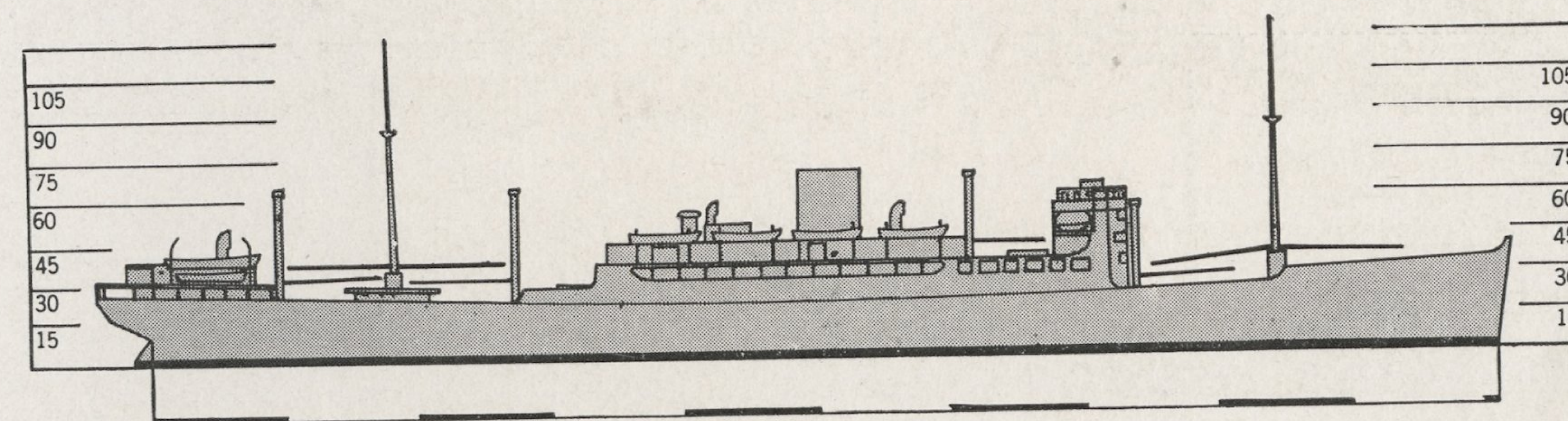
