

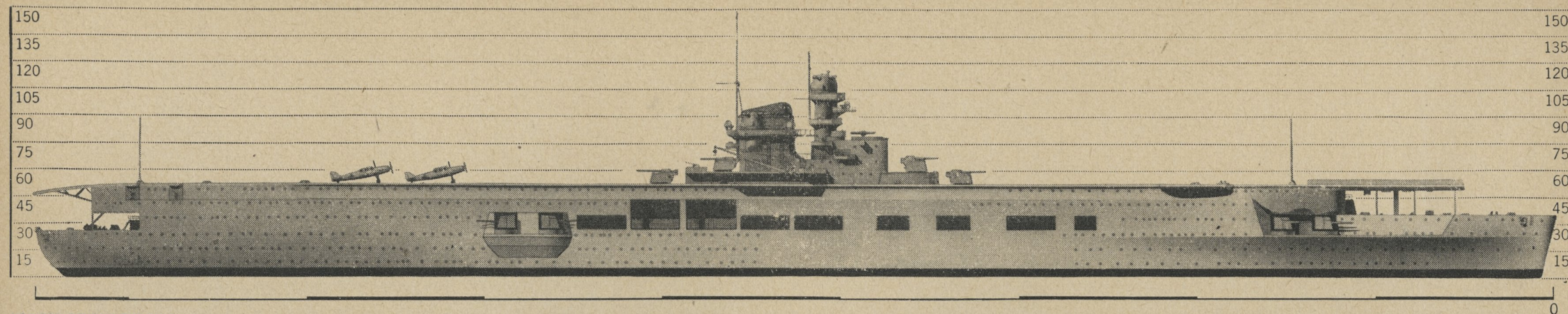

HEIGHT OF OBSERVER



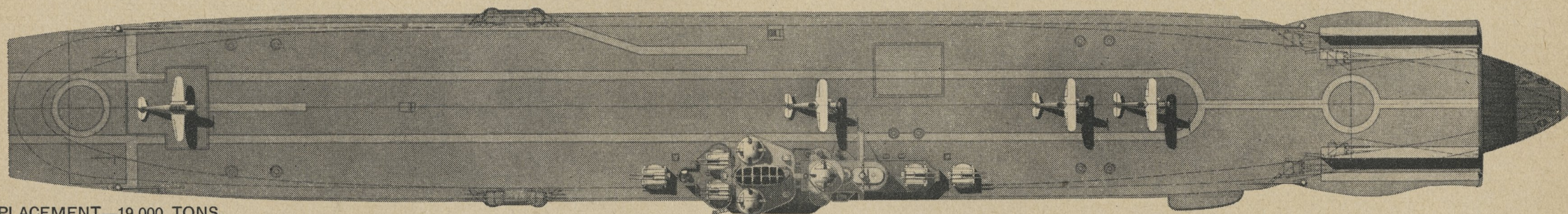

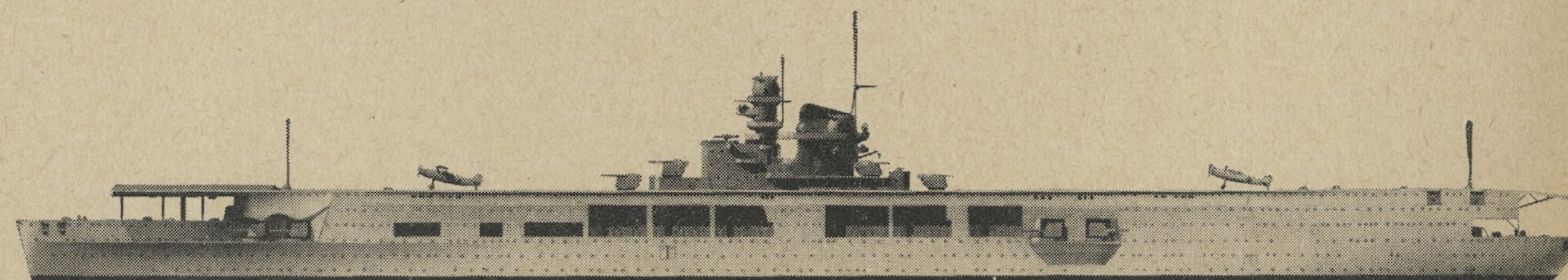
