as in "good standing" if his note given
^{for} the State Agency Fund to his sub-alli-
ance is past due and unpaid, but
has paid his quarterly dues?

Has there not been an order from the
Ex. Com. of the St. A. - to the
effect that ~~no~~ subscrib-
ers or members
who have not paid
anything to the S. B. Agency



fund shall be deprived of privilege of
buying goods from such agency after
1st Jan'y 1890. If so at what date in
Progressive Farmer was it issued?

In reference to action by Sub. All. on
Your Notice to Sec. of Sub. Alliances to pay
the 5¢ per capita, on males in good stand-
ing, Is it necessary for Sec. of Sub. All.
to wait for order from C. Sec. before collect-
ing said amt. If no funds ^{sufficient} in Treasury
can Sec. of Sub. Alliance collect as the
Quarterly dues are done?

Does this per capita now ordered be credited
for the year 1890 or 1889?

When no funds in Treas. sufficient as above,
are new members joining since Oct. last or
in the 1st Quarter of this year, subject to such
levy?

As there has been some appo-
sition about these points, am com-
pelled to have full answers.
