To Business Agents and others having ordered or ordering Bagging:

DEAR BRETHREN:—The Executive Committee of the State Alliance have placed in my hands \$3,000 with which to pay for Bagging. Of this amount I deposited with the mills \$1,000 as a guarantee fund, which leaves me \$2,000 to work with.

On shipping the Bagging the mills draw on me, and on and after October 10th, their shipments each ten days will exceed \$5,000.

I ask that all having placed orders for Bagging, or placing orders, to send the money for each shipment **ten days** in advance of time to ship. I shall be able to ship more promptly after October 10th.

If the mills fill their contracts, we will have no trouble to ship as fast as wanted October 15th.

 Please comply with the above.

Those sending money **first** will be **served** first.
