Our

me to ask you for a ruling
on the following: -

"I claim
that a member does not
stand suspended by the
5th article & Sec. 1st of the
Constitution until 3
months has expired
from the time to which his
dues has been paid".

Please notice that the above is a
quotation.

Also tell us what the word Suspended means as laid down in the Constitution; the person quoted above claims that a person who has not paid his dues for the present gr., cannot receive the new "password", but that "He has" ^{the} right to be a member in good standing for another quarter & receive all the rights and privileges of the Alliance."

Also tell us when the minutes of a regular meeting of an Alliance should be read & approved, or disapproved; at the meeting at which the minutes were taken, or at the following

regular meeting.

Also tell us - if a person had a right to object to the minutes before they have been read to the House & the President asked if there be any objection.

Also tell us - if a member objects to ~~a~~ a ruling of the Chair, & appeals to the House, or makes a motion, or introduces a resolution, & such appeal, motion, or resolution is not put in writing, & the Secretary puts down the exact words of the person making an appeal, a motion, or introducing a resolution, has said for or a right to object to his words, & claim that he meant

something else; & has the
chair a right to make
a ruling in favor of
such objection?

Please consider the
above questions, & let
us have your rulings
on them as soon as you
can.
