My Dear Governor

Our mutual friend Col
B Cannon called to see me today.
I inferred from what he said, he
had seen you very recently, and
if you could be satisfied that Col
Jno I Workhead had not taken any
active steps to defeat your policy
in regard to the tax exemption, you
would not object to reappoint
Col M as Director on the part of
the State in N.C.R.R. Corp. He was aux-
ious I should give you this assur-
ance, Col M was appointed one of
a committee of five who should
go with me before the Legislature here

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and endeavor to prevail upon them
not to report favorably any bill
abrogating this exemption clause
and Col Morehead declined to
swear on this Oath. However much
I might desire to oblige Col Cameron
and Col Morehead I could not
conscientiously say that Col M had
not antagonized your policy in this
particular because he had done so in
your hearing. I have heard that he
changed his mind afterward of this
I know nothing of my own knowl-
edge

I want to see you and learn what
your will is respecting the matter now
pending between the N.C. Camp and
R.R. as to the prop earning tax

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And if convenient to you, will go
up next Wednesday & Thursday
If then I can give you any infor-
mation of advantage to either of
these friends I will most gladly
