Boys Must not Smoke Cigarettes
Chicago, Aug. 23.—Hereafter no boy who smokes cigarettes will be employed in the Chicago Post-office. Formerly the rule was merely that boys employed in the post-office could not smoke during working hours. After a conference yesterday between Postmaster Gordon, Geo. W. Hubbard, Lacey Stewart, and W. E. Roberts it was decided that all cigarette smoking by the boys in the office must cease, and that no boys who had ever been addicted to the habit could get a place in the future.

Queer Cases of Lightning
Lightning cut a queer caper at New Salem last night. Mr. and Mrs. John Frost had just gone to bed when a heavy lightning stroke passed and a bolt struck their house. It came down the chimney into their room, struck the floor and then struck Mr. Frost on the head. Frost's neck and turned her around in bed. The head of the bed and the rails were splintered. Said He Would Kill Bryan
Omaha, Neb., August 25.—William M. Williams, a Welshman, employed in a smelter here, announced, it is said, to one of his fellow-workmen today that he intended to kill William J. Bryan when he came to attend the Jacksonian picnic this afternoon. The police were notified, and immediately arrested Williams, but as the charge against the prisoner could not be verified, they released him from custody, as they had reason to believe that the information denouncing Williams was purely malicious.

Stevenson Endorsed.
Chicago, Aug. 27.—At a meeting of the People's party national committee today, the declaration of Charles A. Towne as the vice presidential nominee of the party, after a long debate, was accepted, and the name of Adlai E. Stevenson was put in his place. In the beginning there were three courses advocated by different members of the committee, viz: To nominate a Populist, to leave the place blank, or, lastly, to endorse Mr. Stevenson. Senator Marion Butler, chairman of the committee, in a warm speech of some length, advocated leaving the place blank, contending that Bryan and Stevenson would receive more Populist votes than if a candidate for Vice President was not named, but on this vote was taken.

No New Trial for Powers.
Georgetown, Ky., Aug. 23.—After considering the affidavits submitted by both sides and hearing argument Judge Cantrell today overruled the motion for a new trial in the Powers case.

WASHINGTON LETTER

WASHINGTON, D. C., Aug. 27, 1900.
If Mr. McKinley has no understanding with the powers occupying in China, his actions are difficult to explain. Although not advised by some of the longest headed men in his party, including the U. S. minister to China, to take advantage of the opportunity to withdraw our troops from China, now that the American citizens who were in peril are safe, and leave those nations which are hungry for Chinese territory to settle the squabble among themselves, he has declined to do so. Several days ago, when it was announced that all the troops now on the way to China would be sent to Manila, it was thought that he intended to follow that advice; but within forty-eight hours it has been officially announced that the troops in China would be kept there, and since then, the significant announcement was made that the troops which would go to Manila would not go to take the place of volunteers to be sent home, but to reinforce the force there, and that no troops are to be sent home, until further notice. If that doesn't indicate an intention on the part of Mr. McKinley to play a further hand in the Chinese game, what does it indicate?
