Comparison of cost of transportation over Good, Bad and Medium Roads.

An argument for good roads has been made by an engineer, who has estimated the cost of transporting goods over the highways. He figures that the cost of moving one ton by horse power over one mile of dry sandy road is 52 cents over wet sand, 32 cents over rutted and mud, 20 cents over broken stone and rut, 16 cents over an earth road that is dry and hard, 18 cents over a better stone road, to go of course, 8 cents over a compact gravel road, 8 cents over stone paving, 9.33 cents over asphalt, 7 cents. It is argued that many millions of dollars would be saved if the roads were made available in the markets.

No one who has had reasonable opportunities for observation can fail to be impressed with the number and great resources upon which rest the prospects of a magnificent future for North Carolina.

More favorable indications toward the coalition of that future than it is possible for many sections to hope for. Our location, soil, climate, mineral wealth, water power, the character of our population, are all propitious. There is no reason now, if there ever was, why the young man of this State should go west, south or north to grow up with the country. He will never have a better opportunity to grow up with a country than by staying right at home. If he does that, the only danger will be that the country will outgrow him.

Twice: Every community should take stock of its opportunities. Greenville is well favored. The development in recent years has been somewhat retarded but in taking advantage of the opportunity to become one of the first tobacco markets in the State, some over-sights in other lines are not surprising. It is easily seen, however, that the town has not sufficiently encouraged and developed several industries that would harmonize with local conditions and further the interests of the community. This is a matter for an organization of the business men of the town. Have we a Board of Trade, or something similar? There was a Chamber of Commerce some years ago. What are we doing to keep up with the procession, gentlemen?

Three times: In this connection, it is in order to note whether sufficient interest is being shown in certain improvements that are absolutely essential to the progress of Greenville. If public sentiment is not alive to the importance of this matter it should be enlightened and enlisted. Shake it up on these streets, give it a bath in some sidewalk pool, and rub it down with a slice of the midnight blackness that envelops Greenville when the lamp lighter has made his round. Some day, it may not be in your day, public sentiment may give us a graded school.
