Company Orders for May 24<sup>th</sup> '41

- No 1. Ensign Cornell Officer for the day.
- No 2. Orders for May 23<sup>rd</sup> to be standing orders until further notice.
- No 3. Swearing & Vulgarity in presence of Officers, Commissioned & Non Commissioned will be severely punished. All officers & soldiers must discountenance the habit in mess rooms & in camp.
- No 4. Every act of drunkenness <sup>in camp or out of it.</sup> will be severely dealt with, ~~either in~~ All officers & chiefs of squads will report offenders.
- No 5. All sick men will report themselves immediately to the ~~Physician~~ <sup>Surgeon</sup> & the Surgeon will make a daily report to the Orderly Sergeant.
- No 6. The Commissioned Officers of the Co: will sit at 11 O'clock each day as a Court Martial, to act upon cases of delinquency & hear excuses.

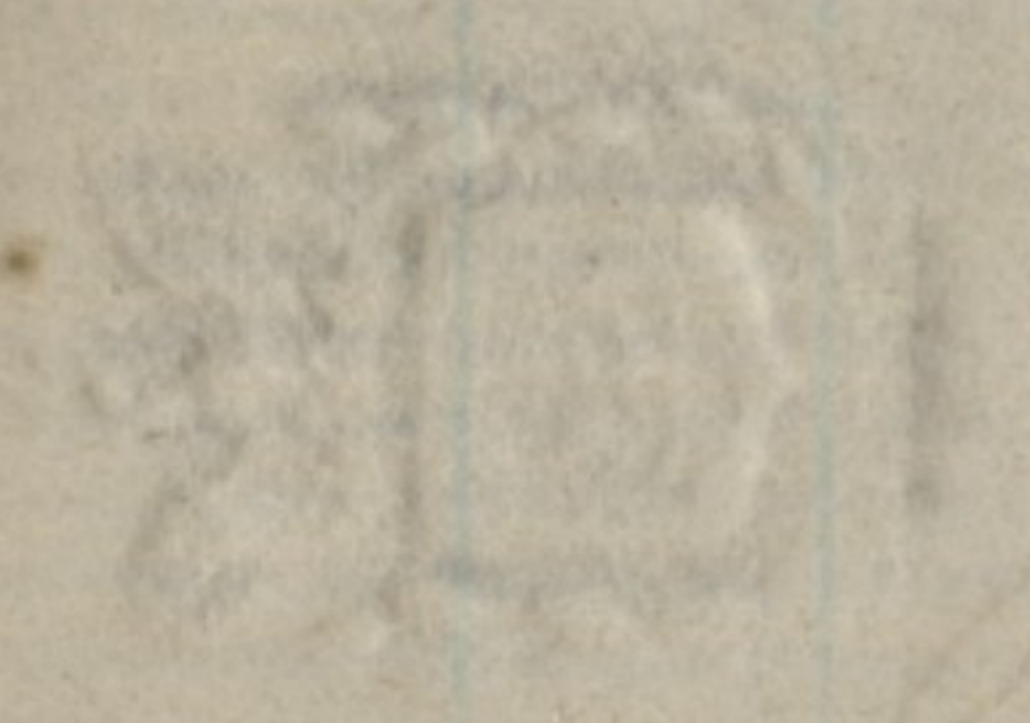
- No 8. Supper immediately after retreat.
- No 9. The Tattos will sound at 10 O'clock P.M. after which no soldier is to be out of his quarters, unless by special leave.
- " 10. No non-commissioned officer or soldier is to quit camp without a pass signed by the Officer of the day or Captain.
- " 11. No officer or private, is on any account to sleep out of camp without permission.
- " 12. No officer or private is to visit Beacon Island, without a special permit in writing signed by the Captain.
- " 13. Immediately after Reville roll call, the ~~Officers of the day~~ quarters & space around them will be put into complete order by the men, superintended by the Chiefs of the Squads. Also the Guard House by the Guard.

No 14. The officer of the day will in person inspect the mess-rooms at 8 A. M. and at 8 P. M. and will report all uncleanness or disorder to the Captain

No 15. The Company Surgeon will inspect the provisions prepared by the Company Cooks as often as convenient, and see that it is thoroughly cooked, & well prepared.

No 16. The Privies in the enclosure must be kept in cleanly order, and any man detected in a violation of this order will be put under arrest two hours for each offence.
