

6. Strong and Responsive University-Wide Governance is absolutely essential if the precepts listed above are to be followed. Such a system of governance is in place. It is of great importance that the public, the executive and legislative branches of state government, and the leadership of the constituent campuses of The University continue to support that system.

Finally, the consultants concluded that the use of a ten-year planning cycle places the planning horizon so far out as to make it virtually invisible. For that reason, they suggest that their study be viewed as an effort encompassing only the next five years and that a similar effort be mounted in the period 1996-97.
