**NOMINATING COMMITTEE FOR SENATE OFFICERS REPORT**Candidate for Chair of the Faculty:**John Moskop, School of Medicine**

Among the many things I learned as Chair of the Faculty for 1991-1992 was that I had no idea what I was getting into when I agreed to be nominated last spring. I do not have that excuse this year and am nevertheless willing to serve a second term as Chair of the Faculty in 1992-1993. This has been a challenging, but productive year for the Faculty Senate. I was impressed by the spirit and sincerity (and length!) of the Senate's debates over proposed revisions to our Tenure Policies and Regulations. As Chair next year, I would monitor and seek to aid the progress of the new Appendix D through administrative channels. I would also work to sustain a strong faculty role in University affairs, including the continuing implementation of strategic planning and in the implementation of the recommendations of the SACS reaccreditation report.

Candidates for Vice Chair of the Faculty:**Patricia Anderson, School of Education**

Serving as Vice Chair for the current academic year has added to my perspective about the role of the various members of the ECU community. I have been pleased to see the positive interrelationships among faculty, staff, students, and administrators, noting especially their singleness of purpose in ensuring that ECU moves forward in its goal of becoming the best institution of learning that it can be. During this exciting year we have all worked to resolve many major issues for which implementation and continuing discussions will be critical in the next academic year. I am especially interested in continuing to serve as Vice Chair of the Faculty so that I can assist in leading those deliberations. Providing leadership for the efforts of the Faculty Senate, various committees, and other groups interested in promoting ECU in positive directions is a major contribution I wish to make. At the community level, I have served as Chair of the Greenville Planning and Zoning Commission, the Greenville Subdivision Review Committee and as a member of the Medical District Land Use Study Committee. If elected Vice Chair of the Faculty I will fulfill the duties of the office with an emphasis on faculty governance and a commitment to the University's strategic planning process.
