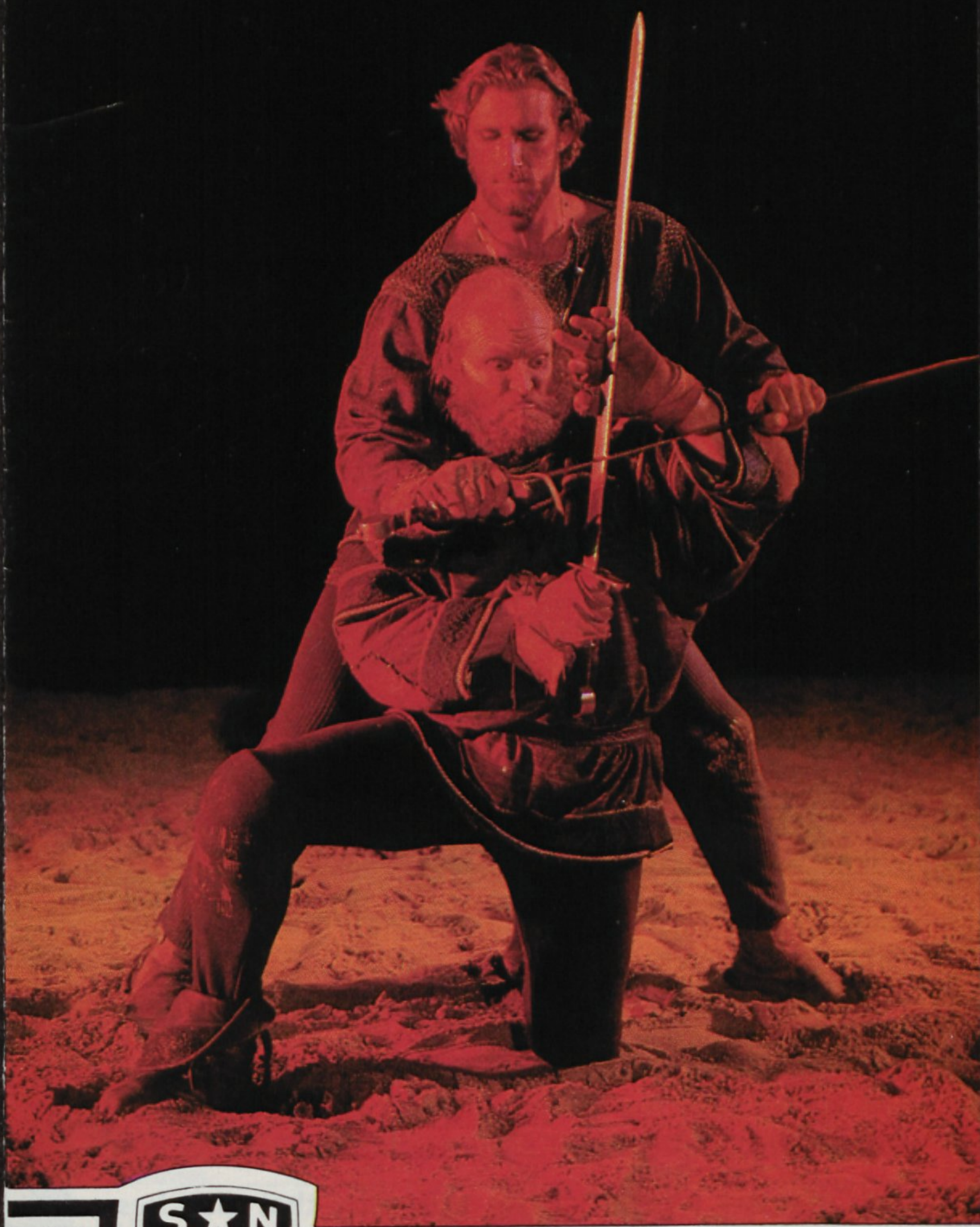

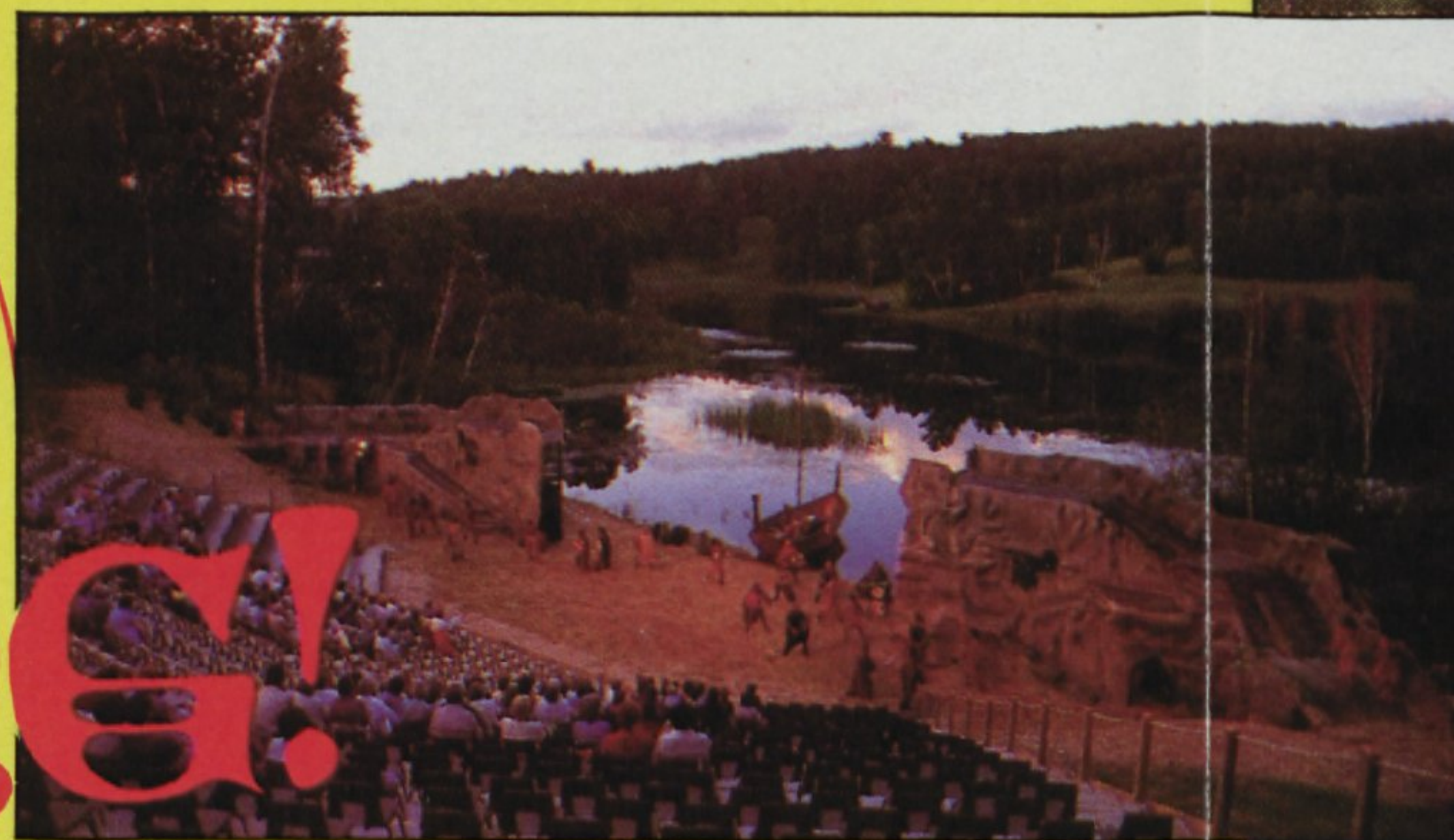
As the Sun Sets in the West....

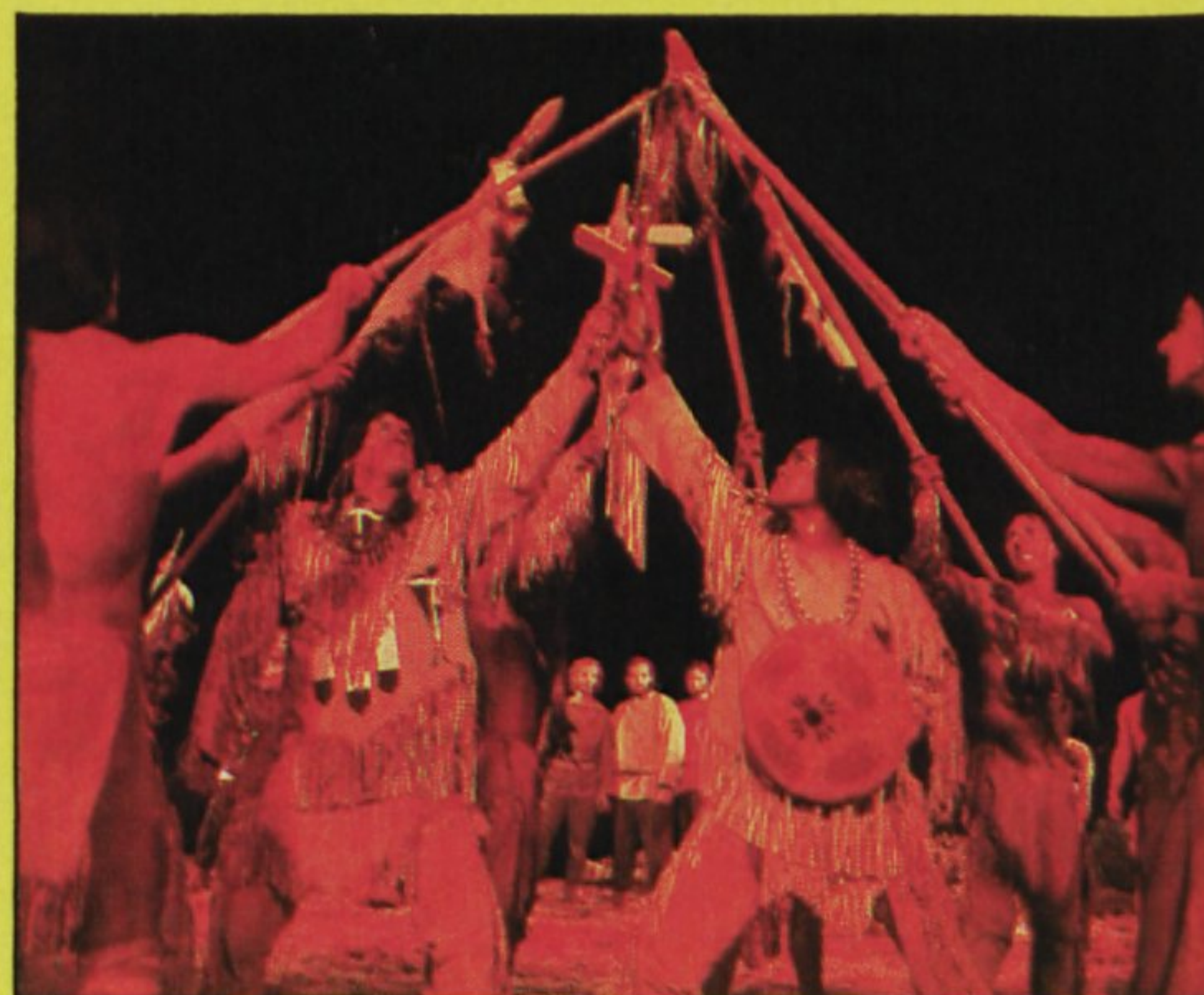
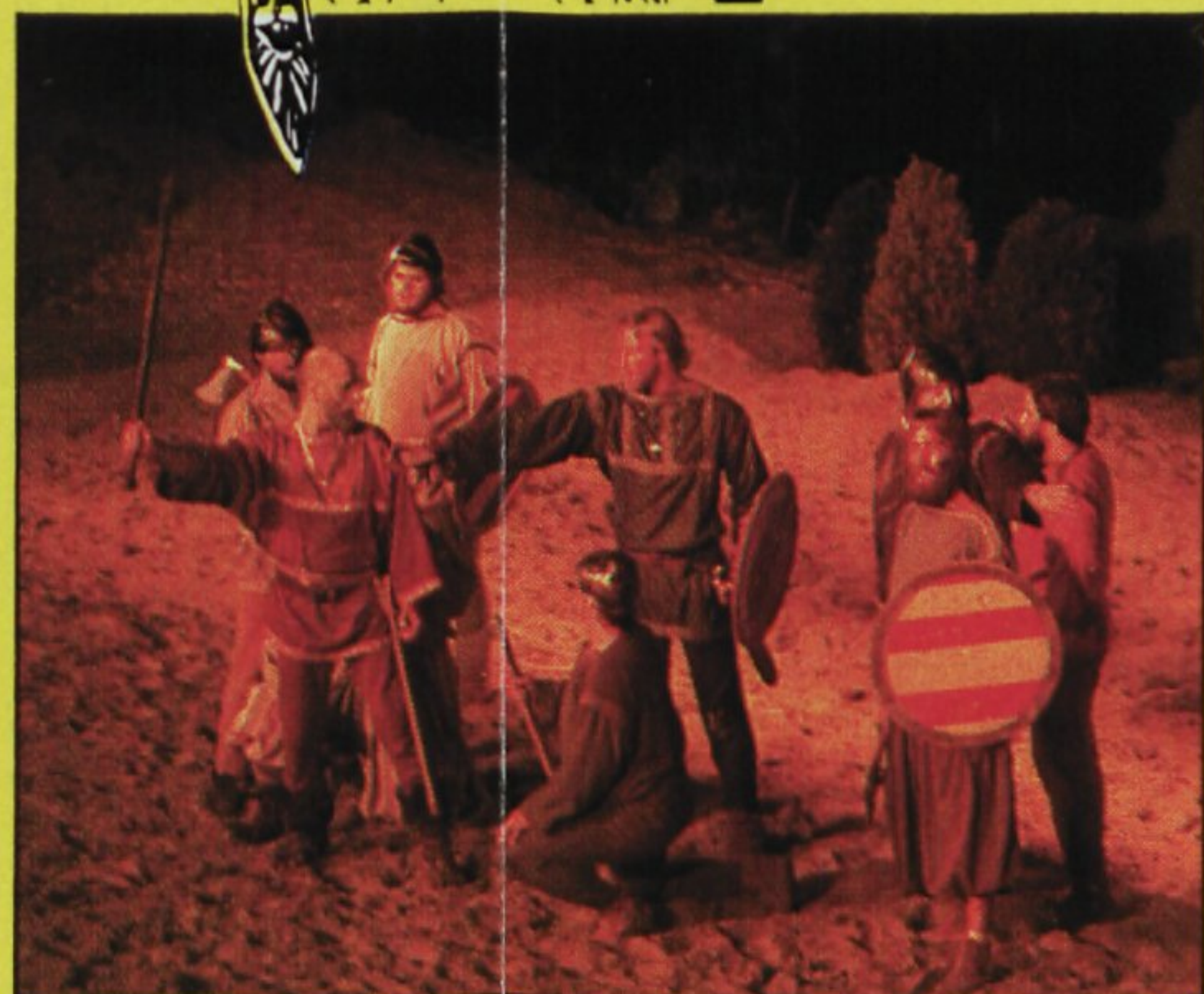
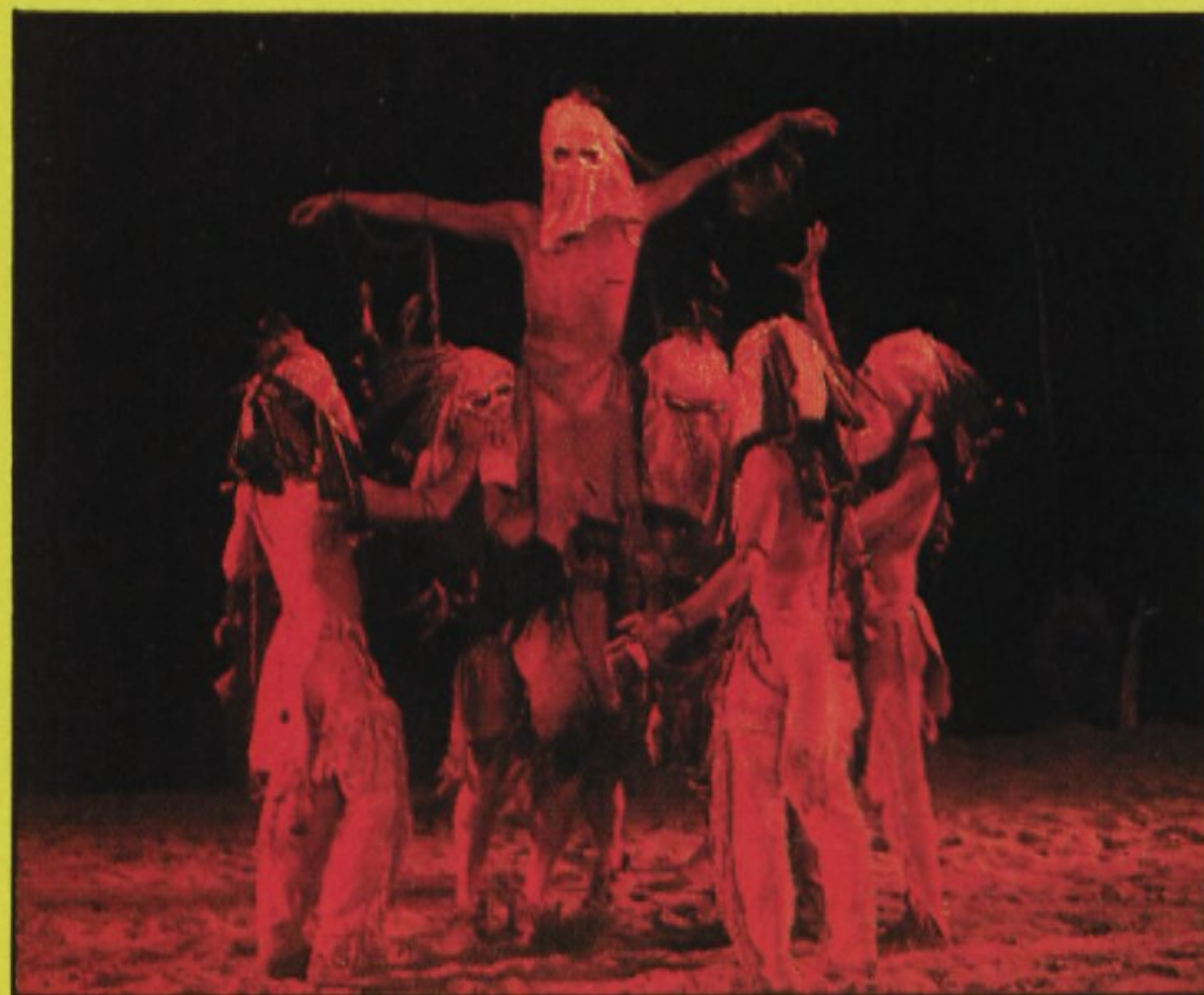
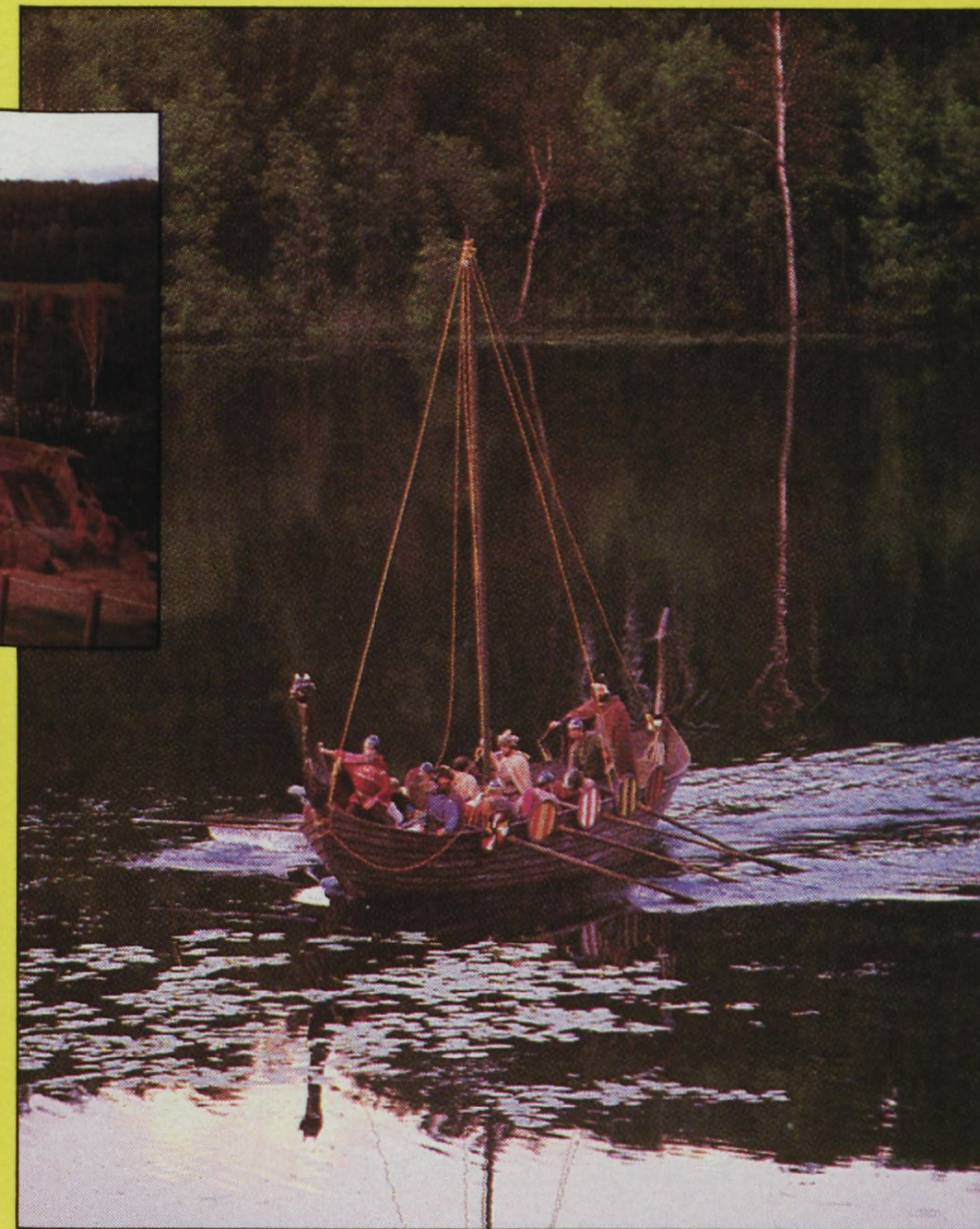
Dining....

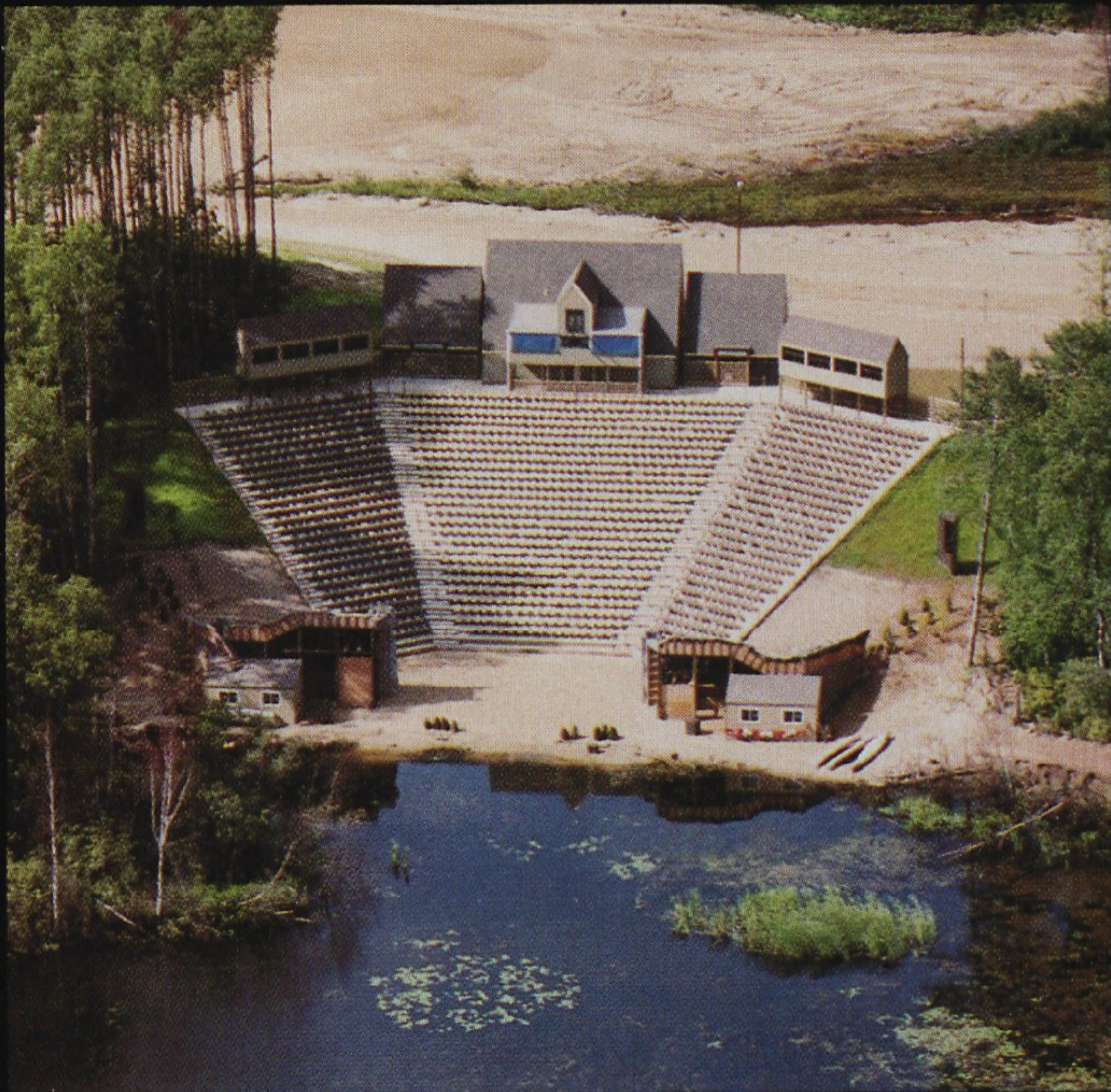

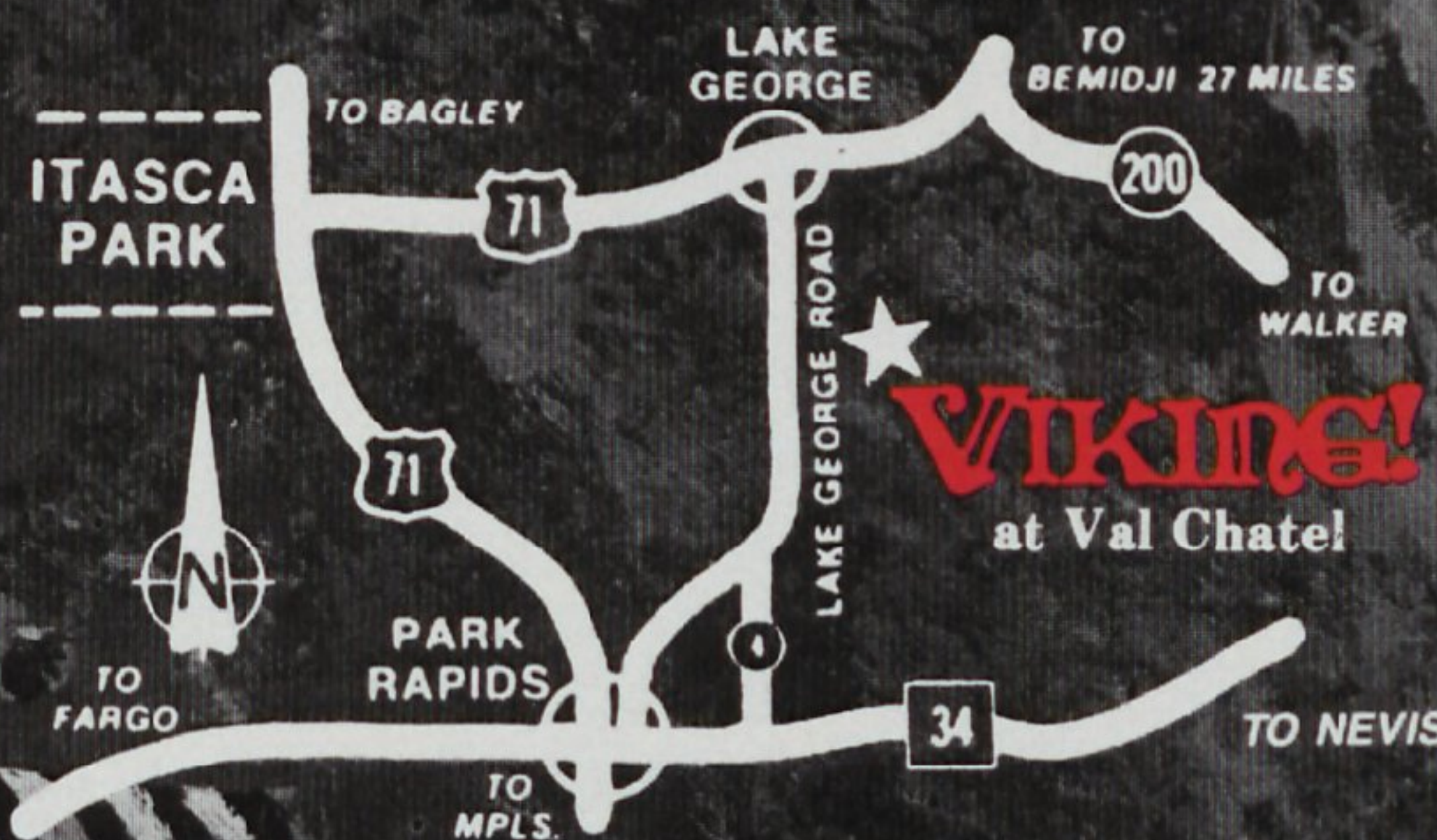

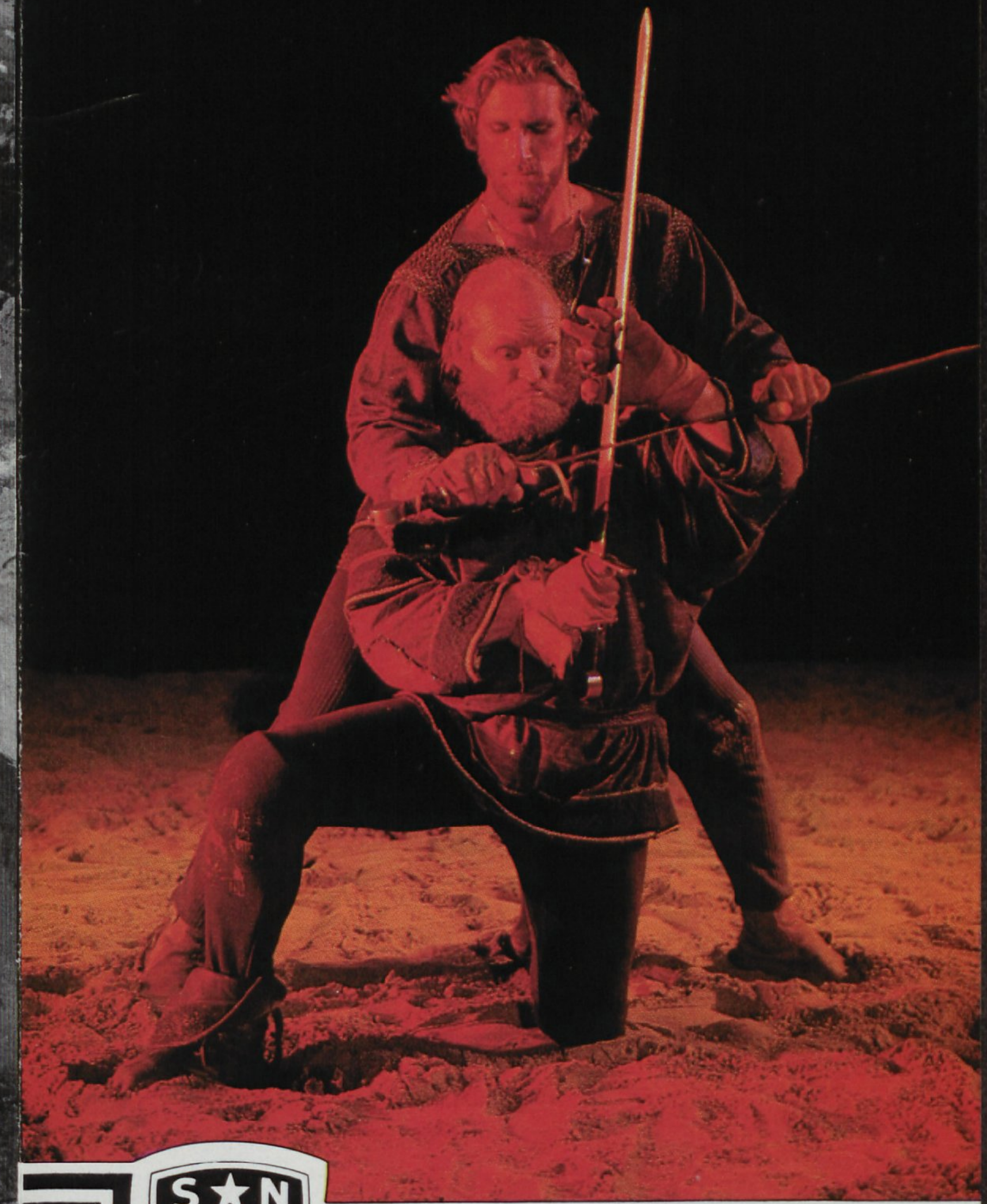
