Dear brother these lines will inform you that my family are Enjoying Common health at present hoping you and yours are Enjoying the like blessing me and all my family has bin very sick with the bad cold that has bin raging over the country but thank God we have all got well again but there has bin a grate many deaths in my knowledge with the same complaints I have nothing of importance to inform you at this time Cotton is selling very low and from 6 to 8 cents Corn from 4 to 5 Dollars I have seasons is very partial in these parts We are dry at this time

A.B. I wish you to write me a letter as soon as convenient ~~and~~ to as I wish to hear how you all are in health and how you come on with settling the Estate buisness I have nothing more at present but remain yours untill death
