N^o 133. Know ye that we have granted unto Thomas Respeck six hundred and forty acres of land in our County of Beaufort, on the South side of Pamlico River, and East side of Durham's Creek. Beginning on said Respeck's line that joins Palmer's Patent at a pine, running East three hundred poles to Simon Whitson's line, then South three hundred and twenty pole to a gum, thence West three hundred and forty six poles to a pine, thence North one hundred and sixty poles to a pine standing on the line of his other survey then East with said line line twenty-eight poles to a pine, thence North one hundred and sixty poles with said Respeck's line to the first station. To hold unto the said Thomas Respeck his heirs and assigns forever. Dated 28th day of October 1782.
