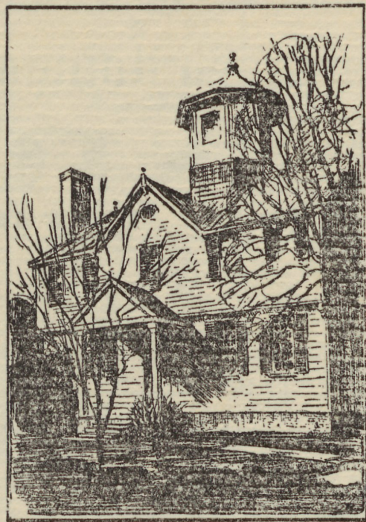

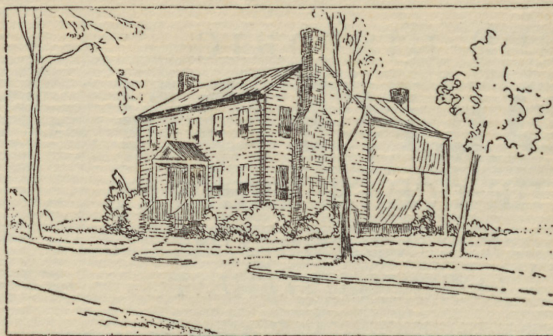

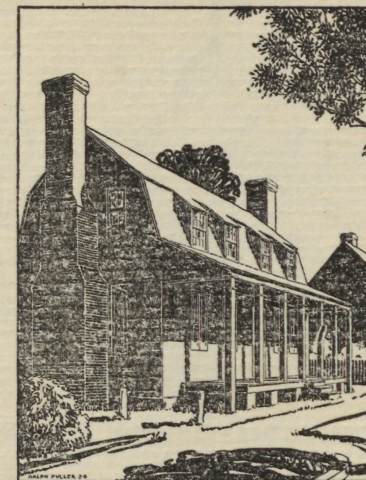

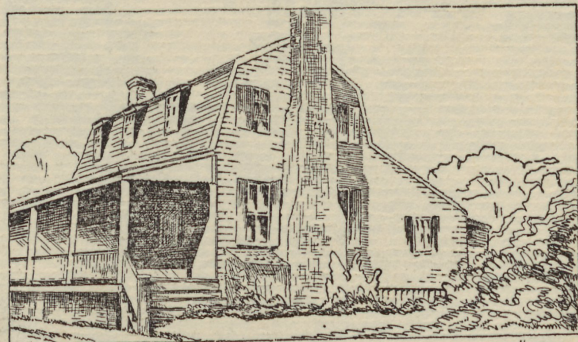
**CUPOLA HOUSE—SOUTH BROAD STREET**  
Erected 1758. Now Library and Museum



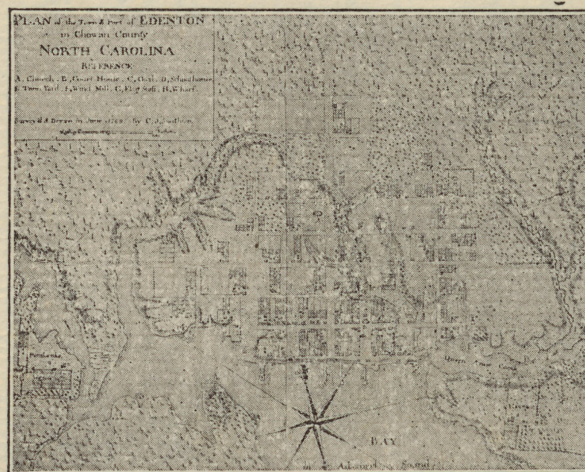
**ALLEN HOUSE—WEST KING STREET**  
Home of Joseph Hewes, Signer Declaration of Independence. First Secretary of Navy. Patron John Paul Jones.



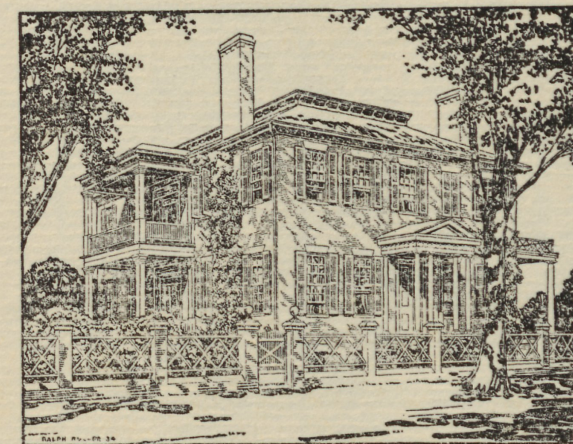
**BOOTH HOUSE—EAST CHURCH STREET**  
Erected Before 1769.



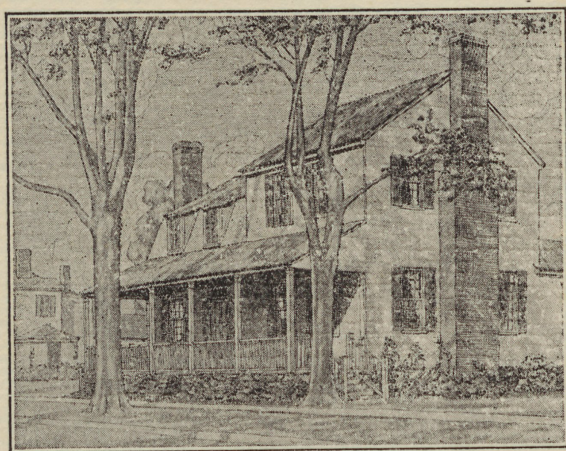
**SAWYER HOUSE—WEST EDEN STREET**  
Erected Before 1769



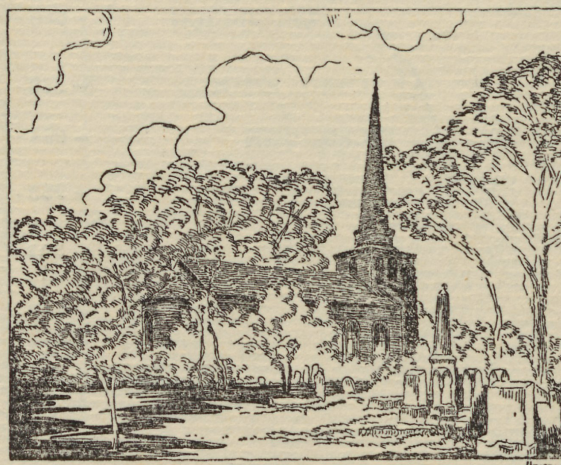
This Map Published In London In 1769 Shows Location of Most of Buildings Pictured Herein.



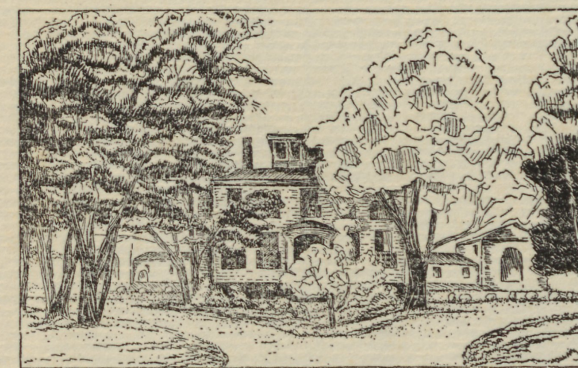
**BEVERLY HALL—WEST KING STREET**  
Old State Bank. Bank Discontinued By Andrew Jackson.



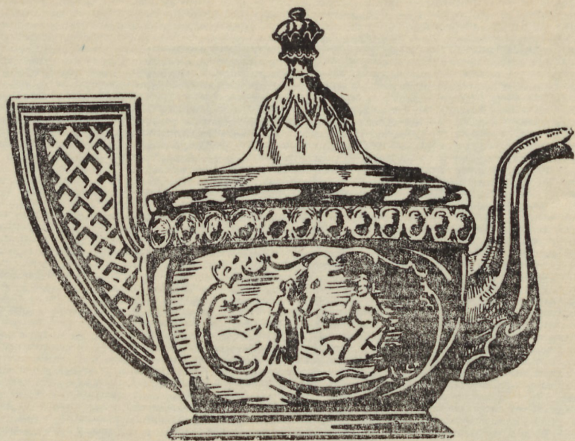
**BOCKOVER HOUSE—WEST QUEEN STREET**

 Home of James Iredell, Justice First United States Supreme Court

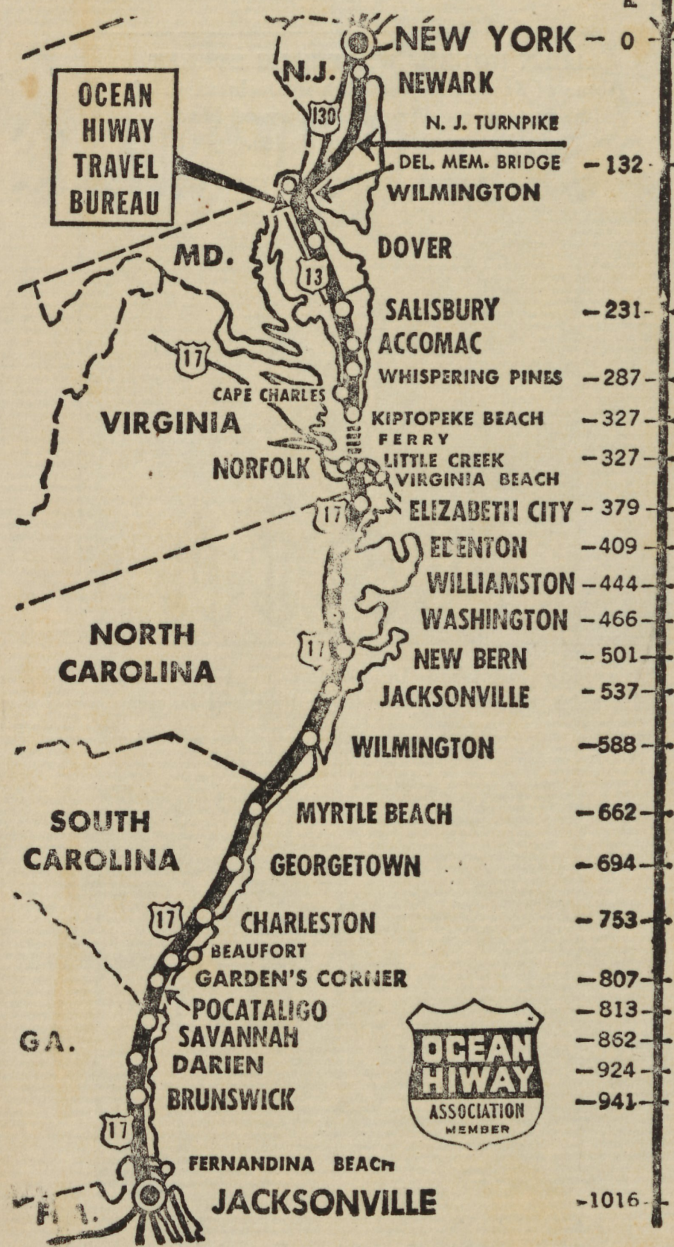


**EDENTON ACADEMY—EAST CHURCH STREET**

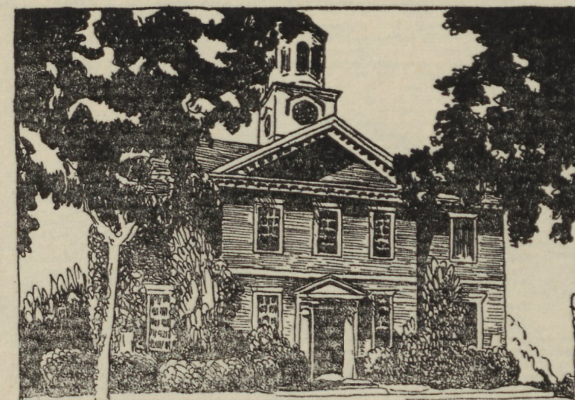
