576—R Potassii iodidi, gr. v.
Potassii bicarb, gr. x.
Mist. ammoniaci, ℥j. —M.

Ft. haustus.

Sig.: To be taken thrice daily. (*In subacute form,
with bronchitis.*) FOTHERGILL.

577—R Potassii bromidi, gr. xx.
Tinct. hyoscyami, ℥ss.
Tinct. lupuli, ℥j.
Aquæ camphoræ, ℥j.—M.

Ft. haustus.

Sig.: Take at bed-time. (*For gouty insomnia.*)
FOTHERGILL.

578—R Granulated efferv. lithii citrat.
(Keasbey and Mattison), . . . ℥iv.

Sig.: One or two teaspoonfuls in water three times
daily. R. V. MATTISON.

579—R Gran. efferv. lithii benzoatis
(Keasbey and Mattison), . . . ℥iv.

Sig.: A teaspoonful in water two or three times
daily. R. V. MATTISON.

580—R Lithii benzoatis, ℥ij.
Aquæ cinnamomi, ℥iiss.—M.

Sig.: A teaspoonful in a wineglassful of water every
four or six hours. (*During intervals.*) JACCOUD.

581—R Sodii salicylatis, ℥ij.
Syr. aurantii cort., ℥j.
Aquæ, ad ℥iv.—M.

Sig.: A tablespoonful three times daily, in conjunc-
tion with rest. Joints involved are wrapped in cotton-
wool. (*During acute attack.*) JACCOUD.

GUMS.

582—R Tinct. myrrhæ, ℥ii-iv.
Aquæ, vel infusi cinchonæ, . . . ℥iv. —M.

Ft. gargarisma.

(*For spongy or ulcerated gums.*) PHILLIPS.

583—R Glyceriti acidi tannici, ℥j.

Sig.: Apply with a camel's hair brush. (*For spongy
or bleeding gums.*) BARTHOLOW.
