

NÆVUS (Continued).

900—R Creasoti, ℥ss.
Sig.: Paint the spots daily. WARING.

NECROSIS (See Caries).

NEPHRITIS (See also Albuminuria).

901—R Pulv. jalapæ co., ℥j.
In pulv. no. xii div.
Sig.: A powder every four hours until free catharsis occurs. To be given after the patient has been rolled in blankets wrung out of hot water. (*In acute nephritis.*) FOTHERGILL.

902—R Pilocarpinæ muriatis, gr. vj.
Aquæ destillatæ, ℥ij. —M.
Sig.: Five to ten minims by the stomach, or hypodermically if uræmia is present. (*In acute nephritis.*) RINGER.

903—R Ext. jaborandi fld., ℥j.
Sig.: Five to ten minims every hour or half-hour, until free diaphoresis is established. May be combined with digitalis. (*In acute nephritis.*) DA COSTA.

904—R Sodii iodidi, gr. xv.
Sodii phosphatis, gr. xxx.
Sodii chloridi, gr. xc.—M.
Sig.: Dissolve in water, and give in the course of the twenty-four hours, either alone, or in milk. SEMMOLA.

905—R Sodii phosphatis,
Sodii chloridi,
Sodii iodidi, āā ℥ij.
Sodii bromidi, ℥j.
Aquæ destillatæ, ℥xiiiss.—M.
Sig.: A tablespoonful four times daily, in a cupful of milk. Used with the following:—

906—R Acidi tannici,
Ext. cinchonæ, āā gr. xxx.
Fuchsin., gr. xv.—M.
Ft. massa et in pil. no. xx div.
Sig.: One pill morning and evening. (*In chronic cases.*) MONIN.
