

PRURIGO—PRURITUS (*See also Skin Diseases*).

1103—R Sodii boratis, ʒvj.
Morphiæ muriatis, gr. vj.
Aquæ rosæ, ʒviss.—M.

Sig.: Bathe the affected parts. Between the applications, lycopodium or starch-powder may be dusted on. MEIGS.

1104—R Morphiæ sulphatis, gr. vj.
Sodii boratis, ʒiv.
Aquæ camphoræ, ʒvj.—M.

Ft. lotio.
Sig.: Wash the parts with warm water and castile soap and apply the lotion twice daily. BAER.

1105—R Lanolini, ʒj.

Sig.: Rub in a portion on the affected surface. (*In senile prurigo.*)

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1106—R Chloral hydratis, gr. lxxv-cl.
Aquæ lauro-cerasi, ʒxiiss.
Aquæ destillatæ, ʒl. —M.

Ft. sol.
Sig.: Apply locally. VIDAL.

1107—R Iodoformi, ʒj.
Ceræ flavæ, ʒvj.
Olei olivæ, q. s. ut ft. ungt.

Ft. ungt.
Sig.: Apply locally. GREGORY.

1108—R Chloral hydratis, ʒj.
Pulv. camphoræ, āā ʒj.
Vaselini, ʒx.—M.

Sig.: Use twice daily. (*In hemiplegic prurigo.*) KOEBNER.

1109—R Cocaini muriatis, gr. v.
Lanolini, ʒj. —M.

Ft. ungt.
Sig.: Apply locally after washing with warm water. (*In pruritus ani.*) BESNIER.
