Caffææ tostæ,
Sacchari albi, āā gr. l.—M.

Ft. pulv.

Sig.: To be used like ordinary snuff.

1214—R Cocaini hydrochloratis, gr. iss.
Caffææ tostæ,
Sacchari albi, āā gr. l.—M.

Ft. pulv.

Sig.: To be used as snuff. (*Used in rare cases where the preceding is ineffectual.*)

1215—R Naphthol (β), ℥iij.
Spts. vini rectificati (90°), ℥ij.—M.

Sig.: A teaspoonful in a pint and a half of tepid water. Use as a douche, or with an atomizer. (*In ozæna and purulent rhinitis.*)
