1290—R Ungt. hydrargyri oxidi rubri, ʒij.
 Ungt. sulphuris, ʒij.
 Acidi carbolici, gr. iij.
 Unguenti simplicis, ʒss.—M.
 Sig.: Apply to the affected parts. (*In chronic eczema.*)
DA COSTA.

1291—R Antipyrin., ʒiiss.
 Aquæ lauro-cerasi, ʒiij.—M.
 Ft. lotio.
 Sig.: Apply as a lotion or on compresses. (*In chronic eczema.*)
CHENNEVIÈRE.

1292—R Olei cadini, ʒss.
 Glycerinæ, ʒj.
 Ungt. diachyli, ʒiiss.—M.
 Ft. ungt.
 Sig.: Apply locally. (*In squamous eczema with thickened skin.*)
TILBURY FOX.

1293—R Hydrargyri ammoniati, gr. xv.
 Unguenti simplicis, ʒv.—M.
 Ft. ungt.
 Sig.: For local use night and morning. (*In dry eczema, or chapped lips.*)
ROYER.

1294—R Acidi acetici cryst., gr. iij.
 Glycerinæ, ℥lxxv.
 Aquæ lauro-cerasi, ʒv.—M.
 Sig.: Apply daily with a stiff camel's hair brush. (*In eczema of the eyelids.*)
LAILLER.

1295—R Resorcin., ʒij.
 Vaselini puri, ʒxviiij.—M.
 Ft. ungt.
 Sig.: Rub in three times daily, and dust on rice-powder. (*In acute eczema of the hands.*)
WIFS.

1296—R Pulv. oryzæ, ʒiiss.
 Plumbi oxidi,
 Glycerinæ, āā ʒviiss.
 Acidi acetici dil., ʒxv.—M.
 [Boil down to ʒxx.]
 Sig.: Use locally. (*In eczema of the hands and fingers. Useful also in painful fissures of the genitals.*)
 This paste resembles, in color, the skin.
