1345—R Hydrargyri ammoniati, . . . gr. v.
Adipis, ℥j.—M.

Sig.: Apply to the surface beneath the scabs, which are removed by poulticing or warm fomentations. (*In impetigo contagiosa.*)
TILBURY FOX.

1346—R Syr. hypophosphiti co., . . . ℥vj.

Sig.: A teaspoonful thrice daily in water. (*In impetigo of the anæmic.*)
JAMIESON.

1347—R Unguenti zinci oxidi, . . . ℥j.

Sig.: Apply locally. (*In the indolent stage of impetigo.*)
RINGER.

1348—R Ammonii sulphoichthyolati, . gr. iij.
Cumarini, gr. viii—xv.
Unguenti petrolei, . . . ℥v. —M.

Ft. ungt.

Sig.: Apply with the finger after bathing and drying the child. (*In intertrigo.*)
LORENS.

1349—R Linimenti aquæ calcis, . . . ℥vj.

Sig.: Use locally. (*In intertrigo.*)
TILBURY FOX.

1350—R Pulv. amyli, ℥iv.
Zinci oxidi, ℥ij.
Zinci carbonatis, ℥ss.—M.

Sig.: Use as a dusting powder. (*In intertrigo.*)

1351—R Bismuthi subcarbonatis, . . . ℥ij.

Sig.: Use as a dusting powder. (*In intertrigo.*)
BARTHOLOW.

1352—R Acidi boracici, ℥iss.
Vaselini, ℥j.—M.

Ft. ungt.

Sig.: Apply locally, after washing and drying the parts. (*In intertrigo.*)
WARING.

1353—R Acidi carbolici cryst., . . . ℥j.
Olei amygdalæ dulc., . . . ℥ij.—M.

Sig.: Apply to the tubercles. The worst spots may be touched with the pure acid, which *blackens* the skin instead of making it white. (*In tuberculous lepra.*)
