Sig.: Emollient bath. (*In erythematous, itchy, and scaly diseases.*)

Aquæ ferventis, . . . cong. xxx.—M.

Sig.: Sulphuret of potash bath. (*In scabies, chronic eczema, lichen, and psoriasis.*)

1440—R Xyloli puri, . . . gr. xlv.
Mucil. acaciæ,
Syr. cinnamomi, . . . āā ℥iiss.
Aquæ menthæ pip.,
Aquæ destillatæ, . . . āā ℥xiiss.—M.

Sig.: A dessertspoonful every two hours. The expired breath of the patients has a strong odor of xylol.

1441—R Pulv. iodoformi, . . . ℥ss.
Pulv. camphoræ, . . . ℥j.
Vaselini, . . . ℥j.—M.

Sig.: Apply to the affected parts of the skin. (*Anæsthetic, antiseptic, and to prevent pitting.*)

1442—R Pulv. folii belladonnæ, . . . gr. vi-xij.
Sacchari lactis, . . . ℥j.—M.

In pulv. no. xii div.

Sig.: A powder every three to six hours, till dilatation of the pupils and some stupor follow. WARING.

1443—R Argenti nitratis, . . . ℥ij.
Aquæ destillatæ, . . . ℥ij.—M.

Sig.: Paint the skin that is exposed to the light. (*To prevent pitting.*)
