1606—R Ext. belladonnæ,
Ext. physostigmatis,
Ext. nucis vomicæ,
Aloini, āā gr. xv.
Ferri sulphatis exsiccatae, ℥j. —M.

Ft. massa et in pil. no. lx div.
Sig.: One pill at bed-time. One grain of perman-
ganate of potash, in distilled water, is also taken thrice
daily. (*In hysterical vomiting.*) BARTHOLOW.

1607—R Cocaini hydrochloratis, gr. vj.
Aquæ destillatae, ℥viiss.—M.

Sig.: Two tablespoonfuls every hour, until six grains
of cocaine have been taken during the twenty-four
hours. To avoid vertigo, the recumbent posture is
necessary. (*In vomiting of pregnancy.*)

1608—R Ext. nucis vomicæ, gr. xv.
Ext. belladonnæ,
Ext. opii, āā gr. iij.—M.

Ft. massa et in pil. no. xx div.
Sig.: One pill at night. (*In vomiting of uterine
catarrh.*) AUDHOU.

1609—R Sodii bicarbonatis, gr. xv.
Acidi hydrocyanici dil., ℥iiss.
Aquæ camphoræ, ℥x.—M.

Ft. haustus.
Sig.: To be taken thrice daily after meals. (*When
due to acidity.*) CHAMBERS.

1610—R Creasoti, ℥iv.
Aquæ, ℥vj.—M.

Sig.: A tablespoonful, repeated as necessary.

1611—R Liq. calcis,
Lactis recentis, āā ℥iv.—M.

Sig.: A tablespoonful every half-hour or hour.
