One thing sure I'm prepared for most any kind of weather. So darling dont worry about me - because I'm alright and am not in any danger. Now I know just how good that makes you feel.

Precious one I had a letter from Fred and he told me that his company would be broken up & made a casual company. He is all upset again and is very anxious about his mail for he feels sure that he will not get all his mail. So tell mother to keep writing him just the same and make he will hear from him once in a while. I will tell you each time I hear from him. I have asked him to request

a transfer to this train. Told him to
ask to be put in either my company
or one of the field hospitals. Do hope he
can get near me.

Well darling I did not write you yesterday
but I'm sure you don't mind me skipping
a day now and then. Yesterday was a
very quiet day. The company was on guard
and I spent a few hrs in listening.

Today we had our usual Saturday in-
spection. This P.M. we gave the boys off
for bathing & working clothes.

This P.M. before I came to my room
I stood & watched the anti aircraft gun
shoot at a German Plane. It was right
interesting. But to my regret the "Boche"
got away.

Today's paper looked very good and I
do hope the Allies can keep the "Huns"
on the run. This is the greatest retreat
of the war and the German certainly must
have lost heavily. But I don't care how
much the loss. Would please me if they
would lose every thing they have.

Noting you said in your letter that
you wanted me to send you a present
to send me a box. Please you have no
idea how much I would appreciate it.

but dear I don't want you to bother about
it. But to please my darling I will send
it to you some time this week. Of course
I feel that it is your wish, and I want
to please you at all time, but really dear there
is nothing that I really need. Now I'm telling
you the truth and I had much rather you
spend the money for your dear sweet self.
than to make up a nice box for me and run
the risk of me never getting it.

There is a large room adjoining mine
and I heard this P.M. that the office were
going to organize a club. I hope so for it
will give us some place to loaf - This room
will make a fine club room if we can get
it. That sound like we are going to be here
for a while longer. I'm hoping & praying that
we will spend the winter in this section.
I do hate to be moving so much.

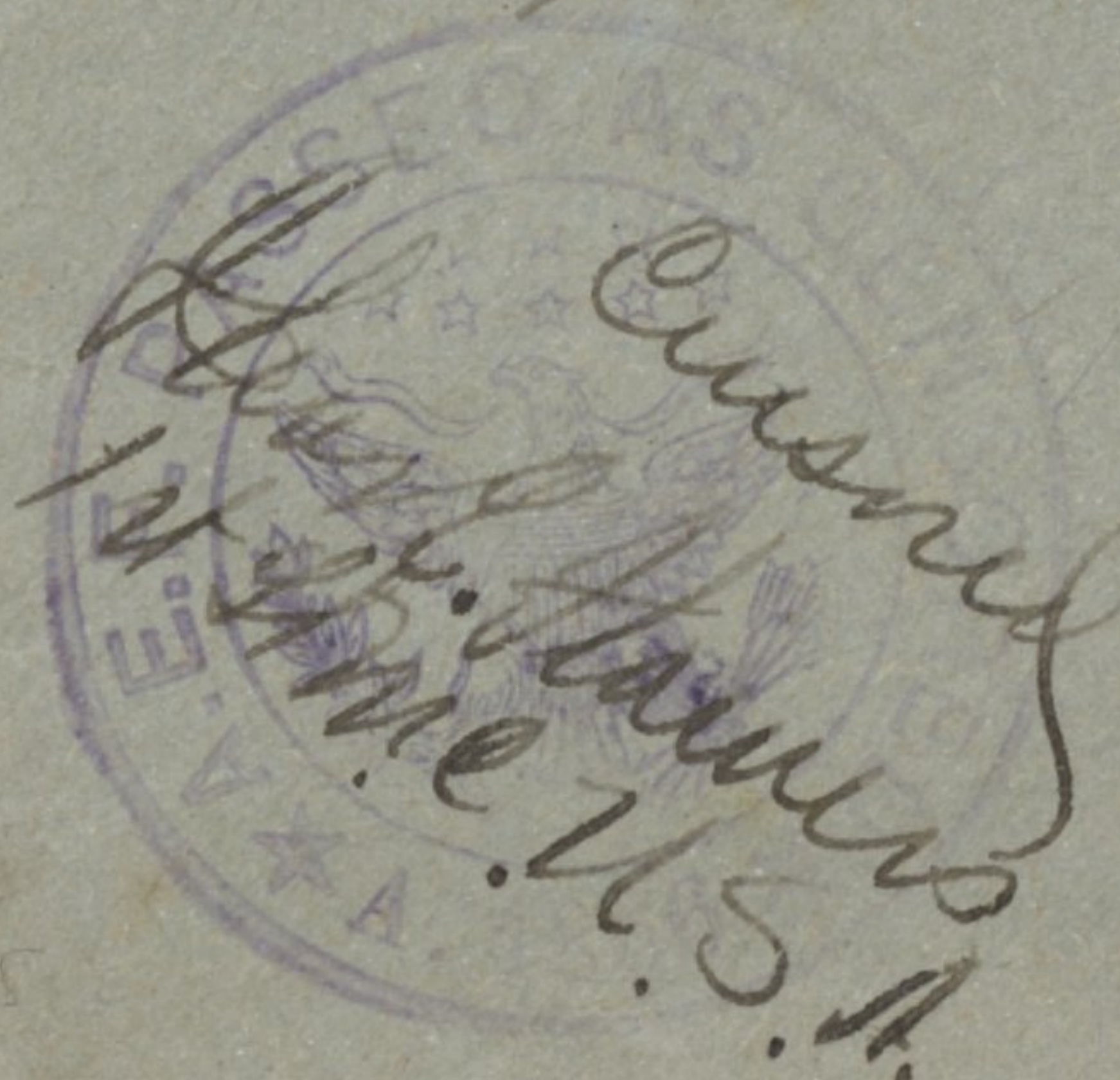
Well darling. Will say good night -
