**ACCIDENT CAUSE**

**“Fidgety” Mindedness Causing Heavy Death Toll  
On Highways**

Raleigh, Aug. 11.—(AP)—The heavy death toll on North Carolina highways is due chiefly to the “fidgety” state of mind of Tar Heel motorists, and until this changes there is little hope of improvement, in the opinion of Commissioner of Revenue Allen J. Maxwell.

“This nervous tension and desire to travel somewhere in a rush,” Mr. Maxwell said, “is costing the lives of hundreds of North Carolinians.”
