of Sixteen pound proclamation money hath bargined
Sold and Delivered and by these presents Doth bargain sell
and doth Deliver unto the s^r. David Adams Certain tract
or parcel of Land Lying and being in the County a fore
said on the East side of Swifts Creek ^{and} north side of perмето
Being part of a patten^t ^{of} four hundred acres ^{of} granted
Containing one hundred and eight acres more or less
Beginning at a small white cove in the fork of the branch
a Cove his house and runⁿ ^{to} 32 pole to a small red cove then
s^r. 63 to a pole to a pine then s^r. 2 yd to an elm in
Butlers line then with his line ^{to} 50 pole to a poplar at branch
then up the Course of the said branch to the beginning
Containing by estimation one hundred and eight acres
more or less to have and hold the a fore said one hundred and
eight acres of Land with the appertenance thereto belonging
unto him the s^r. David Adams his heirs and assigns for Ever
Except the timber of ever pine now standing there on only
such as may be necessary for burning and fire wood and the
William Wennem Doth further covenant and agree to and with
the s^r. David Adams that he is possessed of a good indeceasable
Right in him self and the same will warrant and for ever
defend ^{to} him the s^r. David Adams his heirs and assigns for ever as above
excepted for free and Clear of all manner of incumbrances what
ever his maj^{ties} quit rents only except in witness where of the s^r.
