COVID-19: *Facts* *Fiction*.

DEAR PIRATES,

Although we as a nation were not ready for the unexpected war of the coronavirus, we as a Pirate family will continue to sail through, for we know our final destination is greater!

Here are five socially sound myths with corresponding facts from leading medical experts and health organizations such as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Myth #1: "Only older people can be infected with the coronavirus."



False. Anyone at any age is at risk of getting infected. "It's true that coronavirus is most likely to severely affect people over age 65 and individuals with underlying health conditions, such as asthma, cancer, diabetes and chronic heart disease," Dr. Brandon Brown, an associate professor in the Center of Healthy Communities at the UC Riverside School of Medicine, said. "People in those groups are more likely to have a severe and sometimes fatal illness from a coronavirus infection. But anyone can be infected and pass on the virus."

Myth #2: "COVID-19 is just another flu."

False. While the flu and COVID-19 both cause respiratory illness, they differ in various respects. However there is some overlap between COVID-19 and other viral infections, according to Dr. Bruce Hirsch, attending physician and assistant professor in the Infection Disease Division of Northwell Health, said

"Differences between coronavirus and influenza and more common viruses still in circulation are that we know that the coronavirus binds to receptors in the lower part of the airways, and that accounts for the fact that so frequently, but not always, dry cough along with fever and fatigue are three of the symptoms that are most commonly associated with COVID-19," Dr. Hirsch told Healthline.

Myth #3: "I need to wash my hands with special soap."



False. One of the best ways to avoid contracting the contagious and deadly coronavirus (as well as other diseases) is to wash your hands thoroughly and regularly with soap and water, according to Dr. Frank Esper, pediatric diseases specialist at Cleveland Clinic Children's. "There's no need to buy soaps that are marketed as 'medical' or to only use 'antibacterial' soap," Dr. Hamid Syed, an acute care and primary care physician at Reagan Medical Center in Georgia, said to U.S. News. "Washing your hands often, for 20 seconds with soap and water, is one of the best ways to prevent being infected with the coronavirus. Regular soap is fine."



Myth #4: "Going to a place that's warm can lower my chances of infection."

False. Being in a warm place or a cold location doesn't affect your risk of getting infection, according to Dr. Syed. Health experts and government officials are advising individuals and families to maintain space between themselves and others to stop the spread of the coronavirus. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends maintaining a space of at least 6 feet, according to their website.

"It really does not matter if it's cold or warm outside," Dr. Syed said to U.S. News. "Right now, traveling may not be a good idea because that usually involves going through crowded places and that increases your chances of getting infected or transmitting the virus to other people."

Myth #5: "Antibiotics can prevent you from Getting COVID-19."

False. Antibiotics do not work against viruses, only bacteria. COVID-19 is considered a virus, therefore antibiotics shouldn't be used as a means of prevention or treatment, according to the World Health Organization (WHO).

"This (antibiotics being able to prevent one from getting COVID-19) is not true," Dr. Kecia Gaither, the director of perinatal services at NYC Health + Hospitals/Lincoln, said to U.S. News. "There currently isn't a vaccine to prevent you from getting COVID-19, nor are there any anti-viral medications to treat the disease."

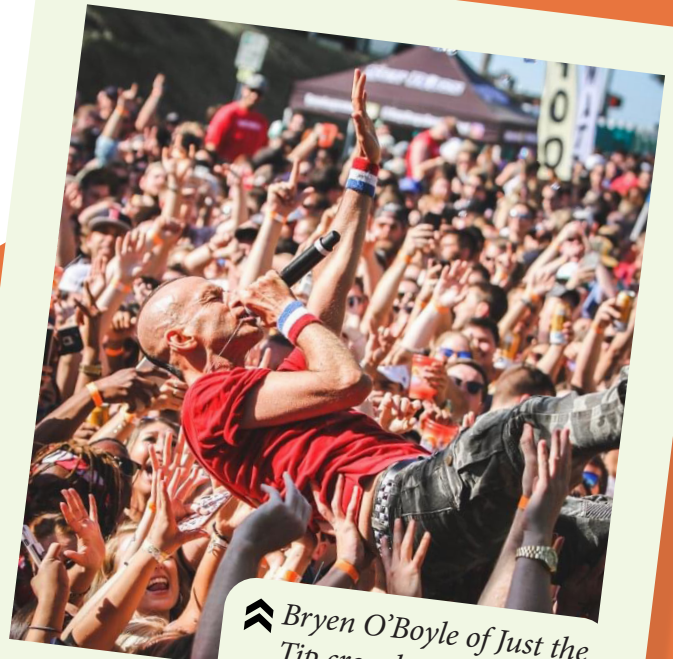
