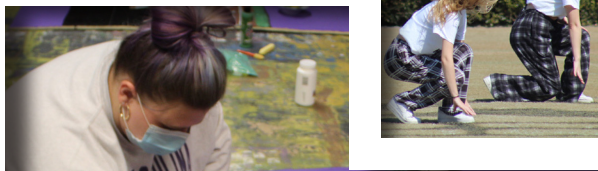
11 ECU BEATS HOUSTON (February 3rd, 2021)

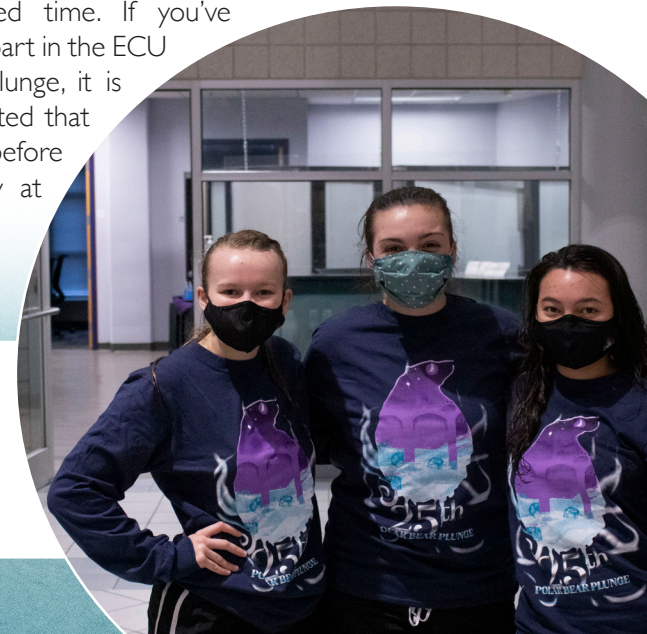
stay on the sidelines of the plunge this year. But it meant a lot to her to have taken part in such a big tradition at ECU, even if just once.

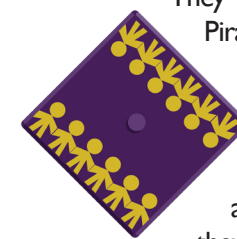
Type 1 - The Reformer

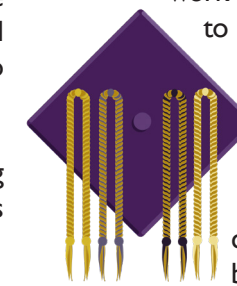
Type 2 - The Helper

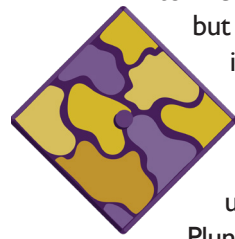
Type 3 - The Achiever

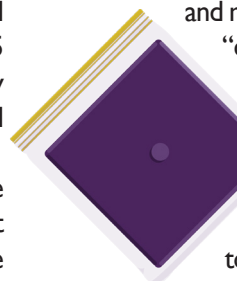
Type 5 - The Investigator

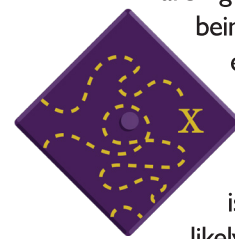
Type 6 - The Loyalist

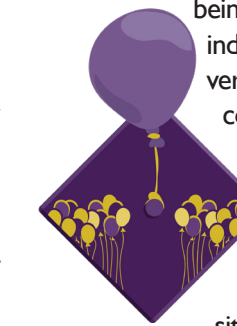
Type 7 - The Enthusiast

Passing the Torch

Let us hear what these ECU alumni had to say about everything from graduation,

THE LAST FOUR YEARS have been a roller coaster ride and one I am not sure that I am ready to get off from. When I think about graduation, I do not know whether to cry tears of happiness or tears of distress; I just know I want to cry. The emotions I feel are excitement, pride, fear, doubt, nervous accomplishment but also failure. We feel that sense of accomplishment for graduating college and starting our lives but what does that mean? That is where the sense of failure starts to roll in, I have made it this far but wonder what do I do now?

"Those feelings can cause an overwhelming feeling of stress and anxiety. After speaking with Breana Bradshaw, an East Carolina University (ECU) alumna, she gave me some insight on how she was feeling during her last semester of college. She explained to me that the nervous feeling I had was "totally normal" and to use that feeling to motivate me to find my next move. As the semester goes on and graduation

is creeping up on us, we are hustling to finish our classes and make good grades to finish strong with. "

While we are hustling to finish strong, we may lose a sense of ourselves, become overwhelmed with everything going on and desperately need a release. David Martin, an alumnae, said "during your last semester make sure you're focusing on

school but don't forget to take care of yourself," a thing some of us not always have time to do. He explained that taking time to care for himself helped him overcome the stress of senior year and this "helped him in the real world too."

"The real world does not stop for you to have a bad day so learning how to deal with this in college gave me an upper hand," shared Martin. He would do things like turn off his computer for a few minutes when he could not focus anymore to rebalance his thoughts or call a friend to vent about life for a few minutes.

For the ones that do not know, it can be a scary time trying to figure everything out. Bradshaw said that setting small goals to accomplish help her get on track to figuring out life after graduation.

Madison Williams, an alumna, said she used her resources on campus such as Career Services or College of Education (COE) Academic Success Center to help her find positions that fit her. Career Services can help you look at positions and jobs in your field that you may not have known existed and put you in contact with the right people. Check out their website, <https://career.ecu.edu>, to set up appointments. Once you find these positions, Martin said, "start applying as soon as you think you are interested and do your research" this way you may have the opportunity to get a job offering before you graduate.

We have started applying to jobs and now we are hearing back from employers that want to meet with us. Here comes the intimidating part, the interview. Before the interview you would want to research your company and prepare some answers and questions before you go. When I asked Williams

Some of us will stay close to home while others venture out into the world and leave our families, possibly for the first time. This can be a frightening transition if we have never been away from family and home. Bradshaw moved from North Carolina where her friends and family are, to Florida where she knew no one. She said the hardest part was being alone and getting into a routine. Her advice on moving far away from family was to "really be willing to open yourself up but stay alert." She said, "be okay with being alone, if you can get past the first three months or so you will be okay."

With all this talk about graduating, applying and interviewing for jobs and moving away, who has time to make sure they are still happy during this stressful process? While talking to the alumni they all mentioned that during this time it is important to make sure you are happy with how things are going and with what you are doing.

"I cried many tears in those final months leading up to graduation (and long after)," said Williams. "But I knew what and who made me happy. For me, it was going to Target and spending time with my family. It's important to find those things/people and to put your self-care first."

It is crucial to have some self-care time in all this craziness we call life. If we do not take care of ourselves then we will not be able to fully take care of and help others in our lives too.

Talking to these different people, who have been in the same pirate ship as all of us, helped me see that I am not alone in all my feelings and thoughts on graduating. Some gold may look like taking some time off and looking for your next treasure map, joining the armed forces, serving your community as an essential worker or teaching the next generation.
