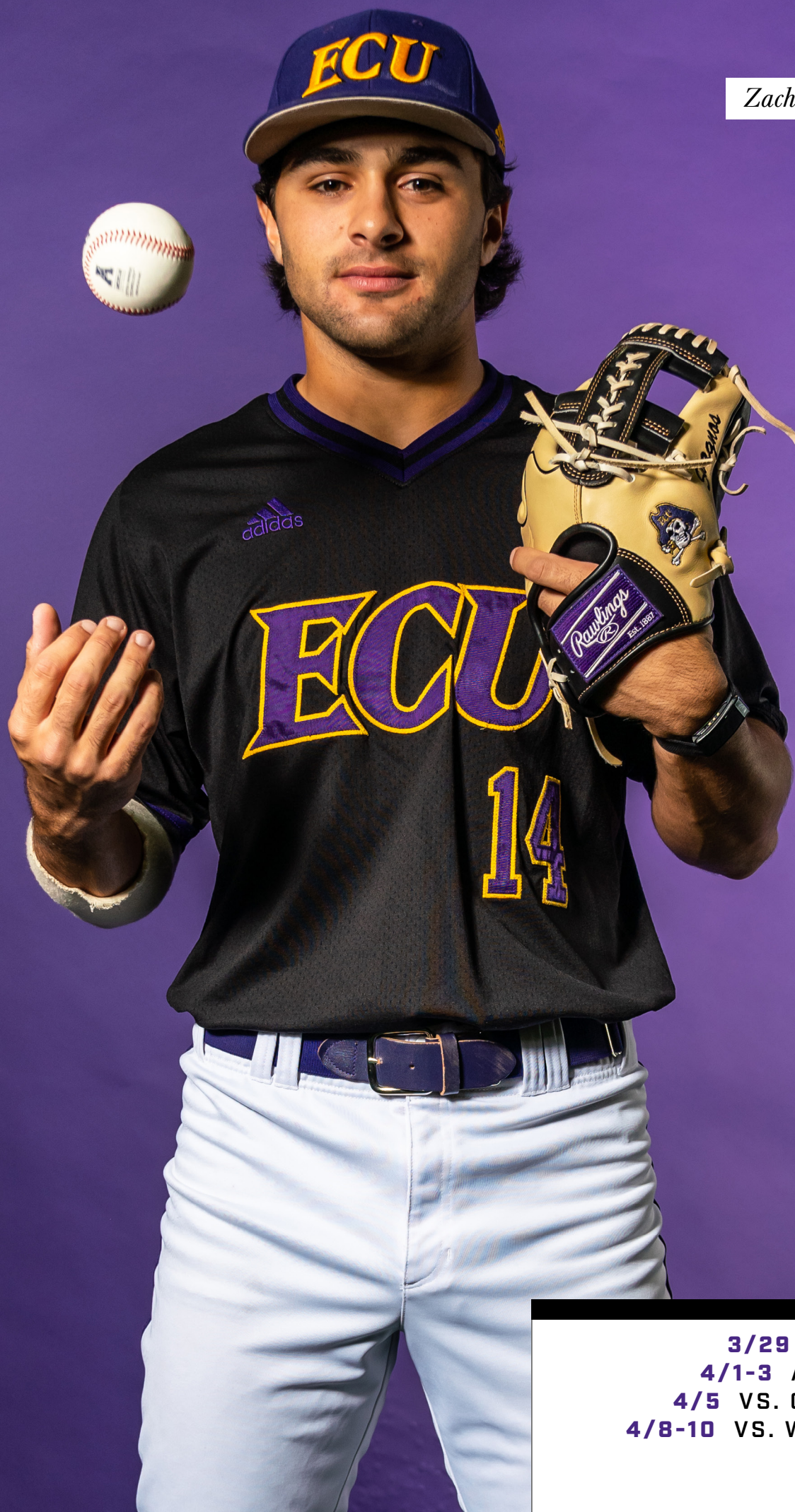

Stoney Beach, Md.



Sophomore Josh Moylan has started 18 of 19 games played for East Carolina this season where he has hit three home runs (tied for second on the team) with eight RBI and scored six runs. The Stoney Beach, Md. native hit two home runs and drove in four during the Pirates 4-1 week, which included victories against UNCW, Elon and a series win over VCU. During his year-plus time in the Pirates program, he has started 76 of 78 games posting a .275 (66-for-240) average with nine home runs and 46 RBI. He has tallied 11 doubles and one triple to go along with 41 runs scored. As a freshman in 2021, he was named to three Freshman All-America Teams (Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball and Perfect Game) and was named a First-Team All-American Athletic Conference member as the designated hitter. Off the field, Moylan is a two-time ECU Director of Athletics Honor Roll member and was named to the 2021 AAC All-Academic Team and is currently majoring in business marketing.

CLIFF GODWIN, who has been a part of 12 NCAA Regional and two College World Series appearances coaching at the Division I level, completed his seventh year as head baseball coach at East Carolina University.

A four-year letterman for the Pirates, Godwin was appointed as ECU's 16th skipper in the school's history on June 25, 2014 after completing a three-year stay at the University of Mississippi.

During his seven years at the helm of the program, Godwin a three-time American Athletic Conference Coach-of-the-Year, has guided ECU to five NCAA Regional berths (2018, 2019 and 2021 Greenville Regional host), three Super Regional appearances, the 2019 and 2021 AAC Regular season titles, a pair of AAC Tournament crowns and a 258-130-1 (.665) overall record. Sixteen players have earned All-America status, while 15 were NCAA All-Regional selections, 23 were named all-conference (18 first-teamers) and 14 were drafted by Major League Baseball teams.

Under Godwin, a two-time Academic All-America selection, the Pirates have had a combined 325 selections on the ECU Director of Athletics Honor Roll (3.0 grade point average or higher). In Godwin's seven years leading the East Carolina program, nearly 100 players have earned AAC All-Academic Team honors - including 38 of 40 members from the 2021 club. The Pirates have earned six-straight AAC and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Team Academic Excellence Awards and five players have earned CoSIDA Academic All-America honors since 2016.

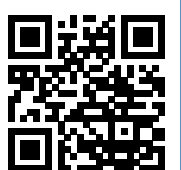

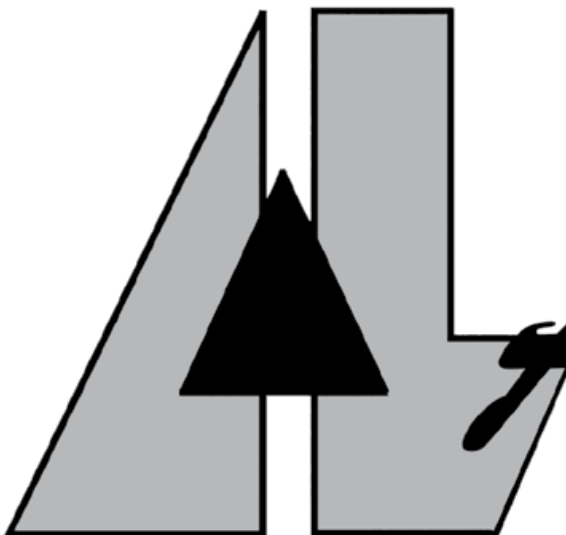
