

Chris Brown Pleades Guilty



(June 23, 2009) - Chris Brown pleaded guilty Monday to assaulting Rihanna and the two were ordered to stay away from each other, in a deal that keeps the singer out of prison but requires him to clean up graffiti or roadside trash, blackamericaweb.com reports. Brown's plea to a felony charge will subject him to substantial scrutiny by probation officials, and the judge's order halts any chance for reconciliation between the young crooner

and Rihanna. Brown entered a plea that will subject him to probation for the next five years and force him to perform six months of community service. Mark Geragos, Brown's lawyer, said the plea represented the singer taking responsibility for his actions, which included hitting, choking and biting Rihanna during a brawl in February, according to police. The judge also told the pop singer, Rihanna that she, too, shouldn't get any closer to Brown than the order allows. "This is a kid who's never been in trouble before," Geragos said of Brown after the hearing. "He embraces this as chance to get the message out that domestic violence will not be tolerated. He wants to get his life back on track."

Mike Tyson Daughter dies after tragic accident

May 27, 2009) - Exodus Tyson, the 4-year-old daughter of infamous boxer Mike Tyson, has died one day after her neck apparently got caught in a treadmill cord at her Phoenix home, the Associated Press reports. "There are no words to describe the tragic loss of our beloved Exodus," the family said in a statement. "We ask you now to please respect our need at this very difficult time for privacy to grieve and try to help each other heal." According to police reports, Exodus accidentally hung herself on a cord dangling from a treadmill in the basement of the family's home. Her 7-year-old brother found her lying listlessly on the floor and called their mother for help. "Somehow she was playing on this treadmill and there's a cord that hangs under the console—it's kind of a loop," police Sgt. Andy Hill told the media. "Either she slipped or put her head in the loop, but it acted like a noose, and she was obviously unable to get herself out of it."

Mike Tyson returned to Phoenix from Las Vegas immediately after learning of the accident. A spokesperson for the Tyson family said funeral arrangements had not been made and a later statement would be released.

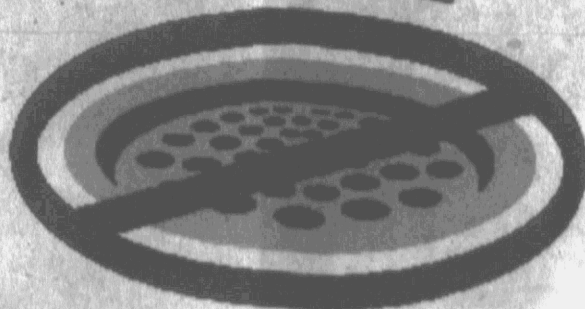
