THE GREENVILLE MARKET.

Everything Ready for the Season's Business.

The Greenville tobacco market opens the new season's business on Monday, August 2nd. Everything on tobacco row is in splendid shape for business and a very active season is expected. With four of the largest and best warehouses in the State, ten large prizeries, three stemmeries, three hog-head factories, a large force of buyers, and plenty of money to pay for any quantity of the weed, there is no reason the Greenville market should not go right ahead increasing in business, as it has done every season so far, consequently the coming season is expected to surpass any former year in the history of the market.

The warehouses were never in better shape for doing business than they are this season. They are all under excellent management, have plenty of room and ample capital. There have been no changes in proprietors of any house since last season. Their working forces for this season are as follows:

WASHINGTON WATER.

(From Our Regular Correspondent.)
 WASHINGTON, July 30th, 1897.

It would be difficult to find a more disappointed and disgruntled gang than those republicans who hoped for some sort of appointment up to the hour of Mr. McKinley's departure on an extended vacation. They had expected that a large number of appointments would be made as soon as Congress was out of the way, but only a few were made and some of them were those whose nominations had failed to be acted upon by the Senate. He added to their disgruntlement by amending the civil service rule so that no office holder in the classified service can be removed except for cause and upon written charges, and then only after failure to make satisfactory defense. He pleased some of the republican Congressmen by excepting from the civil service rules some of the confidential employes in each of the internal revenue and customs districts, but offended others by extending these rules to the smaller Custom Houses that were left out by Mr. Cleveland.

Boss Hanna and Mr. McKinley are said to be 'on the outs', and the big boss left Washington without saying good bye to the man he made President and whom he has been bossing. There are different stories as to the cause of the strained relations, but it is safe to say that they will be patched up by the time Mr. McKinley gets to Ohio, where he expects to be during the latter part of August. As soon as he takes time to think, Boss Hanna will realize that he will need Mr. McKinley in his business before that Ohio campaign is ended, and if necessary will pocket a snub or two to get his active assistance.

Mr. McKinley appointed T. V. Powderly to be Commissioner General of Immigration before he left on his vacation. This appointment was made necessary by the failure of the Senate to act upon Powderly's nomination for this position, and a bargain made before Mr. McKinley's election. It has been hinted by personal friends of Mr. McKinley that he will be rather glad than otherwise should the Senate reject Powderly's nomination next winter. In giving him the recess appointment the bargain that put Powderly on the stump for McKinley has been lived up to. If the Senate declines to let him stay there, Mr. McKinley will have another good appointment at his disposal.

Representative Prince, of Ill., may find it difficult to square himself with the editor of the republican organ at Moline. He had endorsed the editor for the postmastership of the town, and, according to the rule in vogue at the Post Office department, that endorsement should have been equivalent to appointment. But this week Mr. Prince changed his endorsement from the republican editor to George H. McKinley, a nephew of Mr. McKinley. He says he was virtually compelled to change his endorsement, and gives the following as the conversation that took place at the White House between himself and Mr.

McKinley: Mr. McK. — "I wish you would endorse my nephew for the place, Mr. Prince." Mr. P. — "But, Mr. President, I have already endorsed Eastman (the editor), and if I go back on him now I will be held responsible politically." Mr. McK. — "Well, say to them that you endorsed him at my request." Mr. Prince says there was nothing else for him to do after that but to endorse Mr. McKinley's nephew, but he may find that the editor thinks differently, and if he cannot satisfy him in some way he may also find that he has to pay a big price for having to oblige the President.

A study of Czar Reed's committees of the House, announced just before adjournment shows that Pennsylvania and New York, with nine chairmanships each, got one-third of the fifty-four chairmen of House committees, while twenty three states got no chairmen at all. The Eastern States got twenty eight chairmanships. When it is remembered that the legislation of the House is practically in the hands of the chairmen of committees this division is significant of the controlling power.

If proof were needed that Mr. McKinley was virtually compelled by campaign promises to send that currency commission special message to Congress it is easily furnished by the positive statement of prominent republican Senators that no attempt will be made to push the currency commission bill, which was jammed through the House, to a vote in the Senate. It has further become known that Speaker Reed would not have allowed the bill to get through the House had he not been certain that it was to be allowed to die in the Senate. When Mr. McKinley has paid all his campaign debts he may possibly do something because he believes in it, but it seems that there are still a lot of those debts unpaid.

THE GOLD FEVER ON THE PACIFIC.

The Salisbury Truth says: We publish in another column a letter from our old friend, C. C. Ramsay, who is now and has been for several years, in the great State of Washington. This letter, though brief, gives one a fairer idea of the gold craze in that section than any we have yet seen.

Mr. Ramsay is a son of Dr. J. G. Ramsay, of Rowan, and was at home on a visit about a year ago, during which he spent a day in Charlotte. The letter above referred to is addressed to Mr. Wm. H. Stewart, editor of the Truth, is dated Seattle, Wash., July 19, and reads as follows:

Friend Stewart: Thinking you would like some news authentic and direct from the great gold discoveries of Alaska, I enclose herewith some extracts that will interest our home people. Some of these stories read like fairy tales, but knowing the men as I do, seeing them leave here eighteen months ago with barely enough money to land them in Alaska, and then see them return, many worth \$10,000, others \$50,000, and not a few over \$100,000, it is no wonder the whole Pacific coast is wild with excitement.

This is no guess work, for these men brought back the dust, and it took two big express wagons, guarded by eight men with rifles, to haul the gold from the boat to the express office. The next boat down is expected to bring about \$2,000,000. Every one in Seattle has gone crazy, and the steamers cannot begin to handle the business. Understand our old friend Scott Lindsay is interested in a claim, so he need not worry much about the future. I expect to go into the Yukon next spring myself, and if I am not fortunate enough to locate a claim, work at \$15 per day and board is not bad, you know. All along the Yukon river and its tributaries gold is found in great quantities, and I have yet to meet a miner from Alaska, who would not tell you that concerning the great riches of the Klondike the halt has never been told or dreamed of by mortal man. Certainly nothing in the history of the world equals it even

now where it has only been washed down the river from some fountain source, and when that is discovered it will simply revolutionize the financial system of the United States if not the civilized world. With my best wishes for you personally, and kindest regards to my Rowan friends, I remain,

Writing Deeds.

The Record has been requested by one of its subscribers to explain the law, passed by the last legislature, forbidding persons to write deeds &c., without paying a license tax. This law does not forbid a man to write his own deed or mortgage, as some persons have erroneously thought but applies only to those persons who write deeds &c., for other people and receive payment for such work.

The law referred to is found in section 36 of the new 'revenue act,' which levies a license tax on every practicing lawyer, and says that 'any and all persons who shall write deeds, mortgages, conveyances or other legal instruments for a pecuniary consideration shall be deemed as practicing law and subject to the tax imposed by this section.'

Some magistrates and other persons have been in the habit of writing deeds and mortgages for their neighbors and receiving pay for their work. But now they cannot do this without paying the special lawyer's license tax. If they do, they render themselves liable to fine or imprisonment.—Fittsboro Record.

Twin babies, born May 30th, and together weighing but two pounds eleven ounces at birth, are at the West Pennsylvania hospital, Fittsburg. The babies were kept at home for fourteen days. Then the mother and children were taken to the hospital. The babies were unable to generate enough heat to keep them alive, owing to their small bodies, so they were placed on a hollow rubber blanket filled with hot water, and covered with blankets. They were fed every half hour from a medicine dropper holding twenty drops, and are now so far along as to give ground for the belief that they will live. They have each gained one ounce since birth.

We learn that Mrs. J. C. Trexler, of the county, while milking, last week, was badly gored in her side by the cow. Nine stitches were taken by the doctor who was called in. The wound is not thought to be serious.—Salisbury Sun.
