Absent: Dr. Clinton R. Prewett and Teaching Fellow Dan Winslow


In the absence of Dr. Prewett, Mr. Dixon acted as temporary chairman of the meeting.

Dr. Griffith made a report on the President's Advisory Council meeting which he attended October 29, 1963.


Dr. Mandel reported for the brochure committee that a copy of the brochure was now in the hands of the administration.
