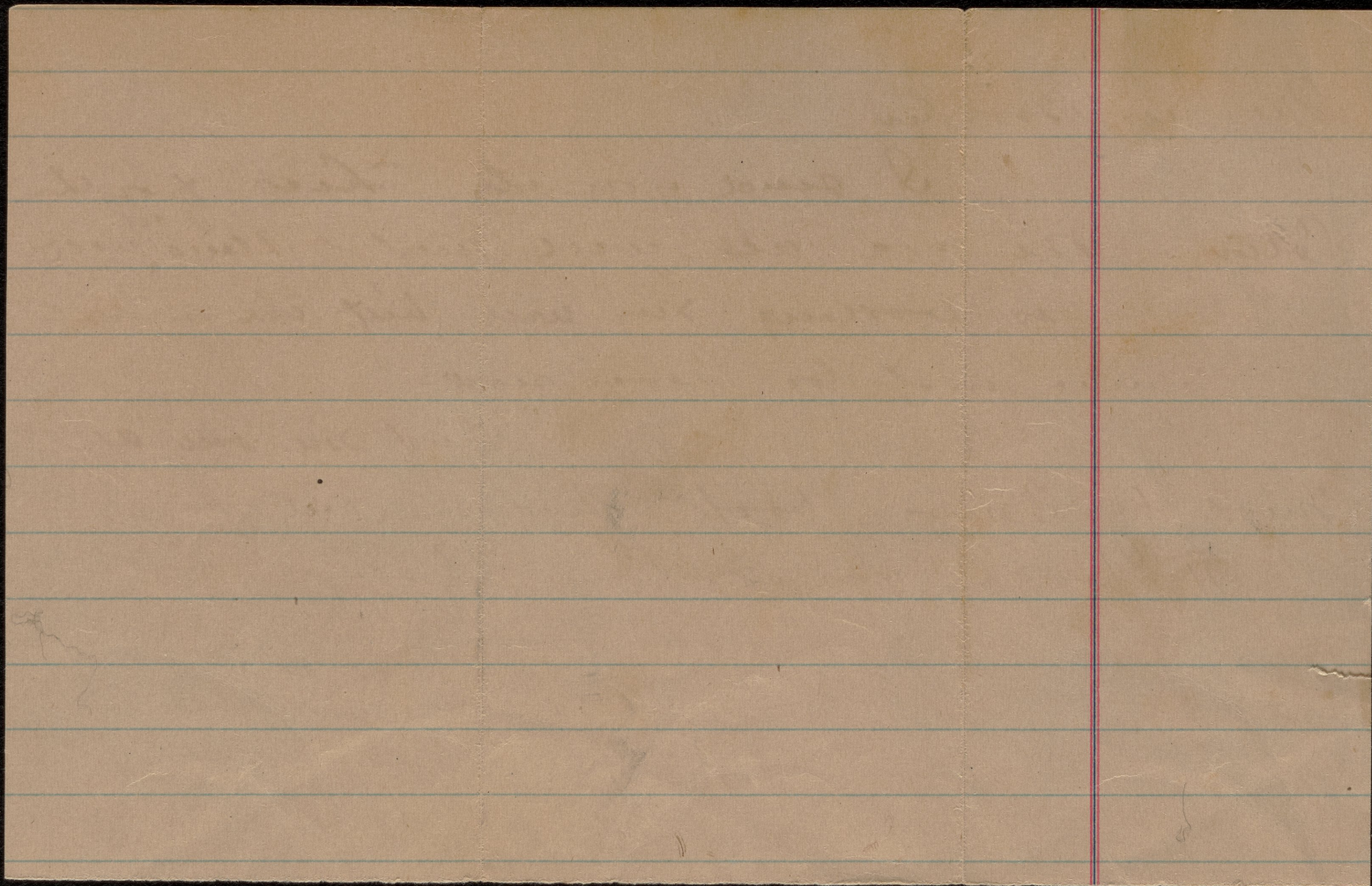

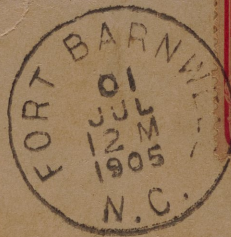
My Dear Brother -
