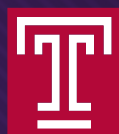

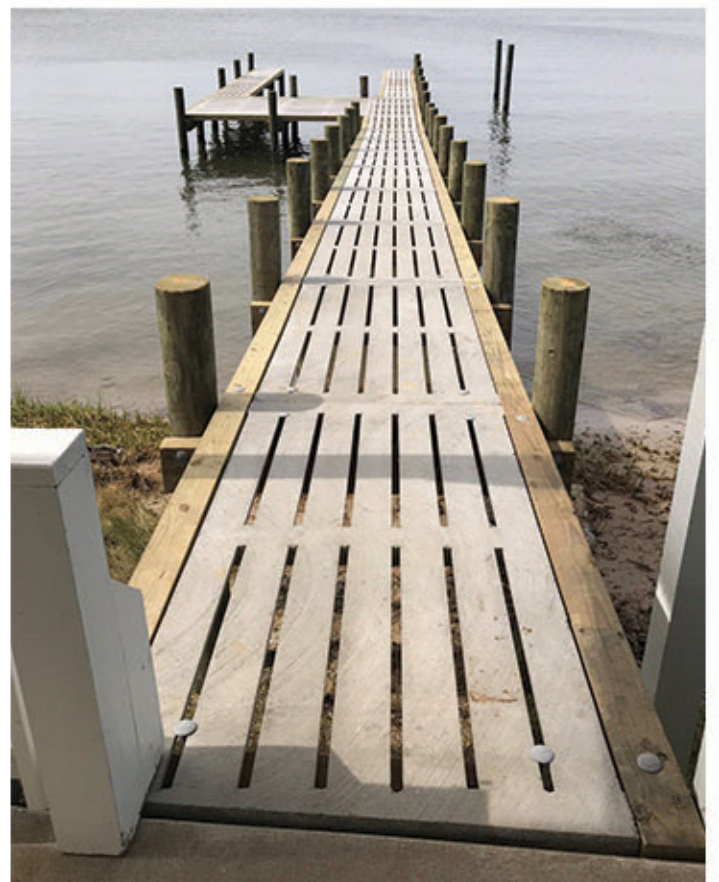

LIVING A PIRATES' LIFE

After having its 11-game streak with at least one takeaway (longest since 2009) snapped during the season opener vs. UCF, East Carolina's defense has started a new run by generating at least one turnover in the last six-straight contests. In all, the Pirates will enter the Temple clash having forced a TO in 17 of the last 18 games. ECU has netted 12 turnovers during the last half-dozen tilts, cashing seven into points (4 TDs, 3 FGs).
